3. Size Limitations: All categories, except Sculpture entries, are not to exceed 153cm in height and width (or equal area) including the frame and must not weigh more than 20kg. TRANSPORTING BY THE KONDININ ARTISTS' GROUP HAS A SIZE LIMITATION OF 1.2M X 800MM WHEN BOXED AND A WEIGHT LIMIT OF 20KGS.
4. A maximum of two entries per category will be accepted from each individual artist. Diptychs & triptychs to be entered as one piece.
5. The Kondinin Artists' Group Inc takes NO responsibility for any delivery or collection costs incurred.
6. Each entry shall be the original work of the artist & not copied in full or part thereof, from any production or published article. Works to have been completed within 1 year.
7. All entries will be eligible for pre-selection. No discussion or correspondence shall be entered into with any person regarding resultant selection or exhibition procedure.
8. The judges & organising committee reserve the right to reject any entry on the grounds that the material, subject, method, production or standard are considered unsuitable for the purpose of the exhibition. Entry fees cannot be refunded.

Kondinin Reserve is behind the Kondinin Railway Line/ CBH



CEO CORNER

We are hoping all residents are well, COVID has been slowly working through our towns and we hope that no one has suffered greatly with it.

JUNE MEETING

At the June Council Meeting, several items were presented to Council. This included:

- A Development Application for an emulsion business in Hyden.
- Consideration of funding towards Mural on the water tank at Yeerakine Rock.
- Council is again looking at differential rates for the unimproved values (Rural & Mining) for the 2022/2023 financial year.
- An item will be going to Council this month to obtain approval of the differential rate in the dollar and the setting of the minimum rates.
- Information on the draft 2022/2023 Budget was presented to Council for consideration.
- Council will be supporting the investigation of getting a vehicle for the East Hyden Bush Fire Brigade. This hopefully will be included in the Emergency Services budget for 2023/2024.
- Council is supporting Hyden VFES with a Christmas in July function to thank all the volunteers for their ongoing support.
- The Shire Policies were under review and several changes were presented to Council and the community for comment which have been reviewed.
- Council has agreed to assist in sending the Kondinin CRC Coordinator to the Town Teams Annual Conference.

INCREASE IN RUBBISH CHARGES

It has come to our attention that the Shire is not covering the cost of the provision of rubbish services to the Shire with the waste service charge. This means that part of your rates are going towards covering the costs of the rubbish service provided.

The shortfall is a significant, but rather than having a single large increase to the rubbish charge, we will be looking at implementing the increase over multiple years. The main aim will be to ensure that the provision of rubbish collection is self funding from the waste services charge placed on properties for rubbish collection.

CPI INCREASES

Most will be aware that there has been significant increase in the cost of living with fuel prices, construction and goods in general increasing in cost. The CPI increase for Perth from March 2021 to March was 7.6%.

Council is aware of the impact on all resident and ratepayers and is attempting to keep the increase in rates for the 2022/2023 financial year within the frames of the Long Term Financial Plan. This will take careful planning and financial restraint. We ask that residents work with us to try and keep costs to a minimum.

Remember, if you are having difficulties in paying your rates this year, please contact the Rate Officer as soon as possible and arrangements can be made for a payment arrangement that will enable you pay by instalments of smaller amounts.

ROADWORKS

The Swimming Pool Carpark in Hyden has only had a stabilising coat put down. The next step will be an asphalt seal and kerbing to complete the works.

Three-ingredient pizza base

🕒 5 minutes prep / 10 minutes cook

Next time you're craving pizza give this three-ingredient pizza recipe a go, it's not traditional but the base uses just three cupboard essentials (plus salt) and the whole thing takes 15 minutes from start to finish.

Ingredients

- 1 cup of plain flour
- 1 cup of Greek yoghurt
- 1 tsp of baking powder
- 1 tsp of salt (optional)

Suggested toppings

- Passata or tomato paste
- Mozzarella or cheese of your choice
- Olives, artichokes, rocket or whatever you feel like

Method

1. Preheat oven to 200c
2. Mix the pizza base ingredients together in a bowl
3. Line two baking trays with greaseproof paper, add half of the dough to each and roll out into a circle 1cm thick.
4. Spread the sauce and cheese on top and sprinkle over chosen toppings
5. Bake the pizza for 10 minutes and enjoy!
