



## Fig and Mozzarella Salad

 Total Time: 20 min    Prep: 20 min



Serves: 4

 Easy!



### Ingredients

- 200g fine green bean, trimmed
- 6 small figs, cut into quarters
- 1 shallot, thinly sliced
- 1 ball of mozzarella, drained and ripped into chunks
- 50g hazelnuts, toasted and chopped
- small handful of basil leaves

### Method

1. Fill a large saucepan with water and let it boil. Also add a pinch of salt to the water.
2. Add beans to the water and blanch for about 3 minutes
3. Rinse them in cold water and then dry on a kitchen paper towel
4. Arrange beans on a platter and then top with figs, shallots, mozzarella, hazelnuts and basil.
5. For dressing, take a small bowl or jar with a fitted lid. Mix vinegar, fig jam olive oil and some seasoning into it
6. Shake well and pour over salad just before serving

TIP: Add smoked paprika powder to the dressing for a spicy flavor

### Ingredients for Dressing

- 3 tbsp balsamic vinegar
- 1 tbsp fig jam or relish
- 3 tbsp extra virgin olive oil
