HYDEN SWIMMING POOL CHANGE ROOMS

Works are nearing completion for the upgrades to the Hyden Swimming Pool change rooms. The new roof has now been installed, building rendered, tiling completed, and the partitions installed. Final plumbing and electrical works and installation of bathroom hardware to be completed within the coming weeks.

This project has been funded through the Federal Governments Local Roads and Community Infrastructure program and has been undertaken by Contractors Solution4Building. Thank you to the Hyden Pool Manager, Wayne Dicker-Lee for being able to continue to manage the pool so well whilst the works were being undertaken and for the understanding of the local community during this time.



COMMUNITY WATER SUPPLY PROGRAM

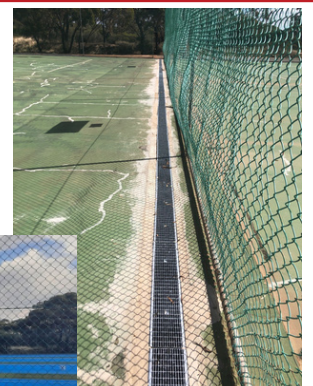
The Shire of Kondinin were successful in receiving grant funding from the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation for the removal of the two old plastic tanks and the installation of a new larger 275KL tank at The Humps standpipe to increase storage at this site together with new pumps and generator sets at the Kondinin Town Dams and Kondinin CBH dam to improve the efficiency and management of water at these locations.



The pads are down ready for the new infrastructure scheduled to be installed in the coming weeks.

HYDEN TENNIS COURTS RE-SURFACE

The Hyden Tennis Courts re-surface is near completion with the drainage works completed and the old surface prepped for the laying of the new surface. West Coast Sporting Surfaces are currently in Hyden undertaking the resurfacing which is scheduled to be completed by the end of May 2023.

KONDININ COMMUNITY SHARED PATH PROJECT UPDATE



The Kondinin Community Shared Path that is currently being constructed between the Kondinin Hospital to the Kondinin Information Bay is progressing well and near completion. The 950m long, 2.5m wide shared path has been constructed under a Western Australian Bicycle Network grant and has been jointly funded by the Department of Transport and the Shire of Kondinin. The section between the Hospital and Stubbs Street was completed in December 2022 by T&D Ibbotson Contractors, with the second section between Stubbs Street and the Kondinin Information Bay scheduled to be completed by the end of May undertaken by Kondinin Building Services.



The formal 'opening' of the new footpath will be undertaken through an event during SOCK (Save Our Country Kids) week in conjunction with the Kondinin Community Resource Centre. More information on this opening event will be made available shortly. It is anticipated that the new shared pathway will greatly improve the safety of cyclists, pedestrians and those on gophers travelling within the Kondinin town site and will connect key services and amenities including the hospital, aged care facilities, skate park and tourist information bay.

ROEROC BENDERING LANDFILL AREA COMMUNITY CROPPING OPPORTUNITY

CEO CORNER

Many thanks to the community members and staff that assisted with the ANZAC Day Services throughout the Shire this year. It is great to see so many of our residents attending the Services to remember those who have served in the various conflicts throughout the years.

APRIL COUNCIL MEETING

At the March Ordinary Meeting, the following items were considered by Council:

- The Asset Management Plan for the Shire was endorsed. This assists with the long-term financial and strategic planning for the Shire.
- Council is considering additional parking areas for the Hyden Hockey players. This area is west of the hockey field to allow easier access for players.
- The Long Term Financial Plan was presented to Council and adopted. This looks at the Shire's long-term financial considerations, including purchases, capital constructions and rate increases.
- Some rates were written off for a property that was sold due to lack of payment of rates. Due to issues with the timing of the changeover, additional fees and accrued which needed to be addressed.
- The Application for funding for a permanent East Hyden Fire Appliance and Facility to house the vehicle was endorsed by Council. This is now up for approval by DFES. This item will be funded (if successful) through the ESL payment included in rates notices.
- The CEO Performance Review was discussed for process and to engage services to assist.
- Finding for an Augmented Reality Sculpture for Hyden/Wave Rock was considered. This item was delayed as more information on the sculpture was required.
- Due to changes in elections as a result of Local Government Reforms, the Shire will be looking at Postal Elections conducted by the WA Electoral Commission

- A confidential item was presented waiving penalty fees for properties in the Shire.
- The 10 Year Housing program of the Shire was presented for consideration in the coming budget deliberations. This document also assists with the longer-term planning and financial functions of the Shire in relation to housing.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS - 2023

The next Shire of Kondinin Local Government Election will take place on Saturday 21st October 2023. For the first time the election will be conducted via a postal vote, with the election managed by the Western Australian Electoral Commission.

The WA Government Local Government Election Reform package has been finalised through the Local Government Advisory Board. Under the reforms, the Shire of Kondinin will reduce the number of elected members (Shire Councillors) by two from nine down to seven.

The reduction will occur over two election cycles (2023 & 2025), with one Office of Councillor to be abolished in October 2023 and a further one Office of Councillor to be abolished in October 2025.

With postal elections, all enrolled electors will be sent a postal voting package approximately two (2) weeks before the pooling day.

Nominations for Council will open on 2nd September 2023 and close 9th September 2023

- The footpath upgrade to Kondinin Part 2 is currently underway and nearing completion.
- Hyden Progress Association will soon be shifting the Old Railway Barracks to the new location making access easier for tourists wanting to view the historic building.

- Entered in the State Register of Heritage Places.
- Identified as being under consideration for inclusion in the State Register.
- An identified Aboriginal heritage site.

One-pan Ravioli Bake



Prep: 10 Minutes



Cook: 15 Minutes



Serves: 4

Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon extra virgin olive oil
- 1 brown onion, finely chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, crushed
- 425 grams Latina Fresh Beef Bolognese Pasta Sauce
- 1 and 1 half cups salt-reduced chicken stock
- 60 grams baby spinach
- 625 grams Latina Fresh Beef Ravioli
- 1 half cup shredded mozzarella cheddar & pecorino cheese blend
- 1 quarters bunch basil, leaves picked

Method

1. Heat oil in a large ovenproof frying pan over medium-high heat. Add onion and garlic. Cook for 5 minutes or until softened. Add pasta sauce and stock. Bring to the boil.
2. Add baby spinach and ravioli to pan and carefully stir to combine. Reduce heat to low. Cover and simmer for 5 minutes or until the ravioli is tender. Meanwhile, preheat oven grill.
3. Top ravioli mixture with cheese. Grill for 2 minutes or until golden. Serve sprinkled with basil.

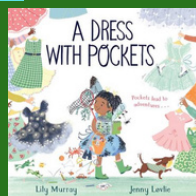
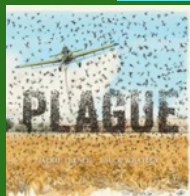

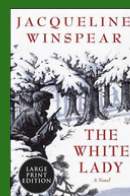
