Important Information:

This application for a Street Trading License will require presentation to Council at an Ordinary or Special Meeting of Council as the case requires; check with the Shire office (contact details at the top of this application) for the next Council Meeting date.

Advice Note: An applicant can apply to Trade without a Street Trading License to the Council of the Shire of Kondinin, pursuant to Subclause 7(b), to permit a proposed trading activity to be conducted without a Street Trading License and payment of any fee. (*This would normally apply only to fundraising and charitable group trading activity*) Please lodge a cover letter detailing your charitable or fundraising endeavour to support your application for this trading activity without the required Street Trading License.

Fees apply and you will be invoiced, subject to Council approval of this application, the prescribed charges pursuant to the length of time sought for the Street Traders Permit and the Schedule of Charges as listed in the 'Second Schedule – Charges' of the *By-law relating to Street Trading* and provided for your convenience:

Second Schedule – Charges:

\$ For a period of One Week or less.....	\$30.00
\$ For a period of One Month but greater than One Week.....	\$60.00
\$ For a period greater than One Month \$60.00 per month or part thereof up a maximum \$600.00 in any One Year.	
\$ Maximum Charge per License application.....	\$600.00

Possible Reasons for Refusal of a Street Trading License Application:

Council **may** refuse to issue a Street Trading License (clause 5) if –

- (a) The applicant has committed a breach of the clauses listed in clause 5(a) of the *By-law relating to Street Trading*;
- (b) The proposed activity or place of Street Trading is in the opinion of Council undesirable;
- (c) The proposed stand, table, structure or vehicle is in the opinion of Council unsuitable in any respect to the location for which the Street Trading License is sought;
- (d) If in its opinion the needs of the District of Kondinin or portion thereof for which the Street Trading License is sought are adequately catered for by established shops or persons to whom licenses have been issued;
- (e) Does not conform to the requirements of the *Health (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1911* (as amended);
- (f) Such other grounds as may be relevant in the circumstances.

Terms Used:

- **Street Trading License** means a license approved and issued by Council in the form as described in the First Schedule of the *By-law relating to Street Trading*.
- **Public Place** includes a street, way and place which the public are allowed to use, whether the street, way or place is or is not on private property.
- **Street** includes a highway and thoroughfare which the public are allowed to use and includes every part of the highway or thoroughfare, and other things including bridges and culverts appurtenant to it.
- **Trading** means selling or hiring of goods, wares, merchandise or services, or offering goods, wares, merchandise or services for sale or hire, in a street or other public place and includes displaying goods, wares or merchandise for the purpose of offering them for sale or hire, inviting offers for sale or hire.
