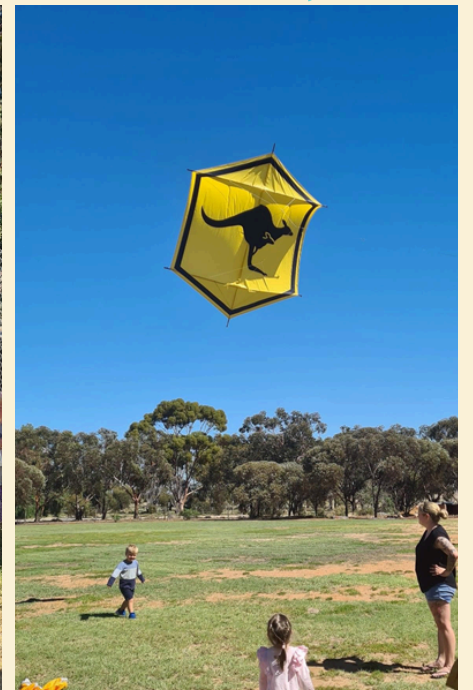

Community News



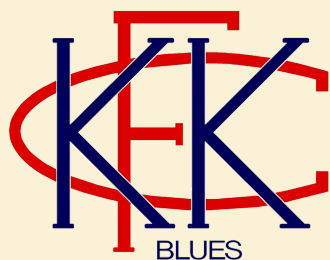
On the 25th of March we had Michael Alvares come to Kondinin to do his Kite Flying and Spinning Flowers Workshop.

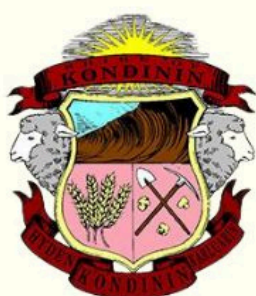

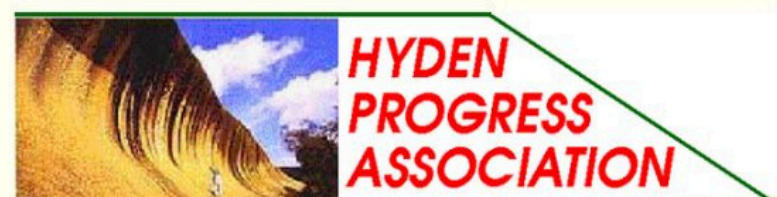

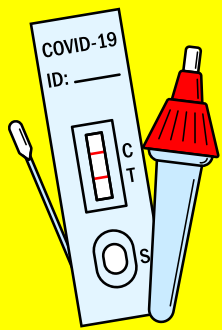

HEALTHWAY – HEALTHY COMMUNITIES PROGRAM



This program aims to fund a range of health promotion activities and campaigns to promote and encourage healthy lifestyles for all Western Australians.

The objectives of the program are to:

- Fund activities related to the promotion of good health in general and aligned with our strategic priorities and population groups.
- Support projects that aim to increase individual knowledge and skills, change behaviour, and create community and organisational policies and environments to improve health.

How much can I apply for? There are three funding categories available: 1. Up to \$5,000 funding, 2. Over \$5,000 funding & 3. Aboriginal health project funding.

Council Meetings

- For the April Ordinary Council Meeting, the following was discussed:
- Rates were written off for 2 properties, one was a mining exploration that ceased to be granted, the second was for a property that had been raised in error.
- An update was provided for the Discovery Centre Project and recent progress for grant funding being applied for and State Government Funding requested.
- Council considered a response to the Standardised Meeting Procedures discussion paper.
- The Shire has agreed to sponsor the 2024 Kondinin Art Festival with the Art Acquisition Prize.
- The Policy and Application form for the Shire of Kondinin Community Grants was amended to allow more flexibility for applicants.

CCTV at Wave Rock

Last year, the shire installed CCTV cameras at Wave Rock which also have the capacity to count vehicles and people. This has provided some interesting details for us on the number of visitors we are getting and the vehicles passing through.

During the Easter Weekend this year, Wave Rock had 3,855 visitors, 1425 on Good Friday alone!

Pumpkin Soup



Total Time: 50 Minutes



Serves: 6



Ingredients

- 2 tbsp Coles Classic Olive Oil
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 1 leek, white part only, finely sliced
- 1 garlic clove, crushed
- 1/2 tsp ground coriander
- 1 tsp ground cumin
- 1/2 tsp freshly grated nutmeg
- 1kg peeled pumpkin, diced
- 1 large potato, peeled, diced
- 1L Massel chicken style liquid stock or vegetable liquid stock
- 1/2 cup (125ml) thin cream

Method

Step 1

- Heat 2 tbsp Coles Classic Olive Oil in a large saucepan over low heat, add 1 onion, finely chopped and 1 leek, white part only, finely sliced and cook for 2-3 minutes, until softened but not coloured.

Step 2

- Add 1 garlic clove, crushed and 1 tsp ground cumin and cook, stirring, for 30 seconds. Add 1kg peeled pumpkin, diced, 1 large potato, peeled, diced and 1L Massel chicken style liquid stock or vegetable liquid stock and bring to the boil. Turn heat to low, cover and simmer for 30 minutes. Allow to cool slightly, then blend in batches.

Step 3

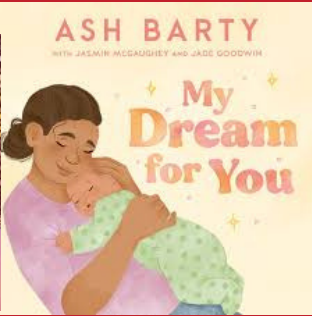
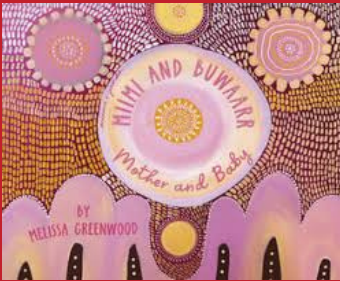
- Return soup to pan, stir through 1/2 cup (125ml) thin cream and reheat gently. Season and add a little more 1/2 tsp freshly grated nutmeg if desired.
