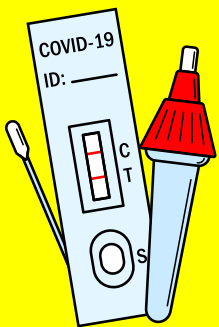

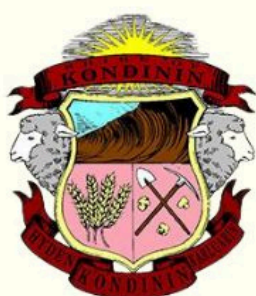

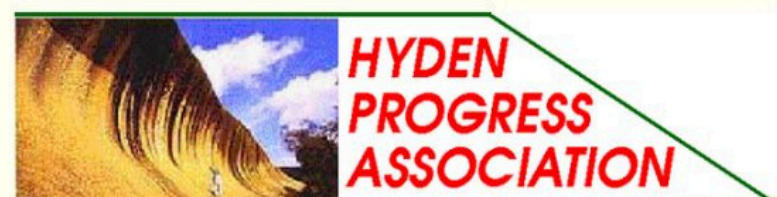

Hope we are all enjoying the cooler weather.

It is also good to see optimism in the air with farmers preparing for the new season following the recent rains.

Council Meetings

For the March Ordinary Council Meeting, the following was discussed:

- A request for Council input into land for the South West Native Title Settlement was requested with Council giving indications of its preferences.
- Council considered quotes for the WACHS Housing project for the style of units. This is now subject to the lease arrangements being finalised and the loan being approved.
- A former Resolution was amended to correct the address details of the Self Supporting loan for Kondinin Community Recreation Council.
- Some unrecoverable debts were written off by Council to remove them from our books.
- Fees and Charges for the Shire were amended to include fees for Street Stalls as a result of the recent Local Law changes.
- An update on the Discovery Centre was provided to Council
- The Compliance Audit Return was adopted by Council for submission.
- Minutes and actions from the Annual Electors Meeting was presented to Council.
- Council will be considering an agreement with the Hyden Lions Club for assistance in keeping the Recycle Area tidy in the 2024/25 Budget.
- An update on the actions from the Corporate Business Plan for the Shire was presented.
- The Shire of Kondinin will again be sending in an application for a permanent fire unit for East Hyden.

- Council has resolved to undertake the actions of the Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation for the Bush Fire Brigades Local Law.

Kondinin Pavilion Upgrade Funding Received

The Shire has received a letter of confirmation from the Minister for Culture and the Arts; Sport and Recreation; International Education; Heritage that the Shire has been successful in receiving \$384,860 of funds for the Kondinin Pavilion Upgrade.

Many congratulations to staff and the Kondinin Community Recreation Council for this project and we look forward to the works going ahead.

Recent Rains in Hyden

Shortly after having a week of 40 Degree heat for the area, Hyden received a downpour of rain with 1/3 of the annual rainfall falling on a single weekend.

The Shire, along with Emergency Services and Main Roads were looking at action should the threat of flooding become an issue.



Several areas of Hyden were flooded and Coronation Park became a pool. The Shire will be looking at some of the drainage issues so that in the future, this can be prevented or limited.

Butter Chicken



Total Time: 35 Minutes



Serves: 4



Ingredients

- 1/2 cup Greek-style yoghurt
- 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 3cm piece ginger, peeled, finely grated
- 2 tsp ground cumin
- 2 tsp ground coriander
- 1 tsp garam masala
- 1/4 tsp chilli powder
- 600g Lilydale Free Range Chicken Thigh, cut into 3cm pieces
- 1 tbsp vegetable oil
- 20g butter
- 1 brown onion, halved, thickly sliced
- 410g can tomato puree
- 1/2 cup Massel chicken style liquid stock
- 1/2 cup thickened cream
- Basmati rice, to serve
- Coriander leaves, to serve

Method

Step 1

Place yoghurt, garlic, ginger, cumin, coriander, garam masala and chilli powder in a glass or ceramic dish. Add chicken. Stir to coat. Cover. Refrigerate for 2 hours.

Step 2

Heat oil and butter in a heavy-based saucepan over medium-high heat. Add onion. Cook, stirring occasionally, for 3 to 4 minutes or until softened. Add chicken mixture to pan.

Step 2 Continued

Cook, stirring, for 5 minutes or until chicken just starts to change colour. Add tomato puree and stock. Cover. Bring to the boil. Reduce heat to low. Simmer, stirring occasionally, for 10 minutes or until chicken is tender and mixture has thickened slightly.

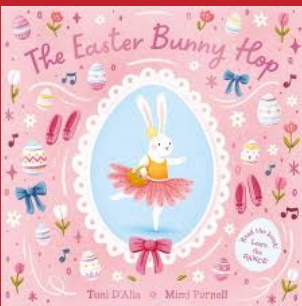
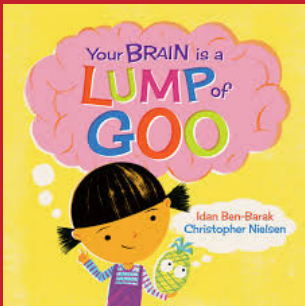
Step 3

Stir in cream and season to taste. Simmer for a further 5 minutes or until heated through. Serve with steamed rice and coriander leaves.
