





Council Meetings

There is no Council Meeting in January, so we have no items that have gone to Council this month.

Residents and Ratepayers are reminded that the **Annual Electors Meeting will** be held in Hyden at the **Recreation Centre starting** from 6pm on 14th February 2024.

Hyden Oval

Due to the shortage of rain this year, we have been trying to keep the Hyden oval going and stretching out the water as much as possible.

We have recently started carting water for this month to keep the ovals going. While this is costly, we know that a lot of the community are on leave at this time of the year and we need to maintain the ovals.

Next month, we will be seeking assistance from the community to help cart water for the ovals until we can get some substantial rain to fill the dams again.

Swimming Pools

had a safety audit just recently and a few minor issues were raised that have been rectified.

One major issue raised was that the 3m diving board at the Hyden Pool is noncompliant as the water depth of the diving bowl is 10cm too shallow. Staff are looking into options of changing this to a platform or other use that would still be an exciting add to the pool and can entice patrons to the facility.

Patrons are reminded that while using the pools, please obey the rules of the centre including:

- No alcohol in the facility.
- No smoking or vaping in the facility.
- Patrons must be clean before entering water shower facilities are provided.
- Appropriate clothing for the pool must be worn.
- Children under 10 years of age must be supervised by a person over 16 years of age.
- People under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be refused entry.
- Other rules that apply are on signs at the pools.

Our pools are great facilities and we want to ensure we can keep delivering these services. Your adherence to the requirements will greatly assist us.

Farewell to Cherith

Many patrons to the Hyden Office will have missed seeing Cherith's smiling face and welcoming manner. We are sad to announce that after a period of leave, Cherith has resigned from the Shire after 25 years of loyal service to our community.

We wish Cherith all the best in retirement, her knowledge and helpful attitude was a great benefit to the Shire and customers.

Electronic Vehicle (EV) Charger in Hyden

Hyden now has an EV charging station in town to allow EV users to come and explore our area.

This initiative was funded through a program with State Government funds and Synergy.

We thank Mark and Tory for their work with Synergy to ensure the best location for the service to be provided. We had several hurdles and lots of discussion before we could use the current location.

Basic chicken and vegetable stir-fry





Ingredients

- 3 chicken breast fillets, trimmed, cut across the grain into thin strips
- 1 brown onion, cut into thin wedges
- 1 red capsicum, deseeded, cut into thin strips
- 250g button mushrooms or mushroom caps, sliced
- 1 bunch broccolini, cut into 4cm lengths 1 tbsp water
- · 2cm piece fresh ginger, peeled, finely grated or chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, finely chopped
- 2 fresh birdseye chillies, deseeded if desired, thinly sliced
- 2 tbsp salt-reduced soy sauce
- 11/2 tbsp oyster sauce
- 100g bean sprouts, to serve
- Coriander leaves, to serve
- · White Medium Grain Rice, to

Method

<u>Step 1</u>

Heat wok over high heat for about 1 minute (see note). Add 1 tablespoon of the oil and swirl it around the wok to coat the entire cooking surface and heat for 30-60 seconds or until very hot. Add half the chicken strips and stir-fry for 1-2 minutes or until the chicken is sealed and just cooked through (see note). Transfer the chicken to a plate and set aside. Add about half the remaining peanut oil to the wok and repeat the process with the remaining chicken strips.

Add the remaining oil to the wok and heat over high heat until hot. Add the onion and capsicum and stir-fry for 2 minutes (see note).

<u>Step 3</u>

Add the mushrooms and broccolini and stir-fry for a further 2 minutes. Add the ginger, garlic and chillies. Season with salt and stir-fry for 1 minute or until aromatic (see note).

Add the soy sauce, oyster sauce and water and toss for about 1 minute. Return the chicken to the wok and stir until the vegetables and chicken are coated with the sauces and the vegetables are tender crisp.

Remove the wok from the heat, toss through the bean sprouts and coriander and serve the stir-fry immediately with cooked rice or noodles.
