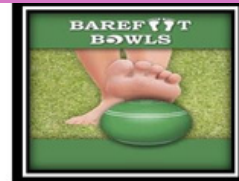

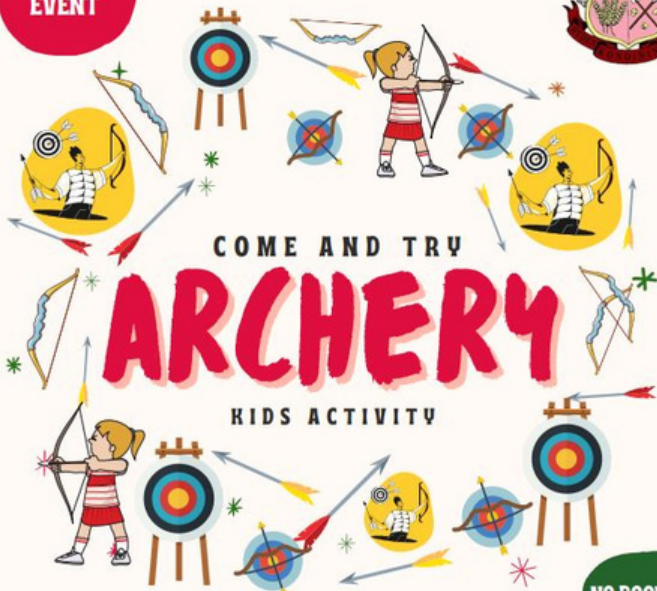
KONDININ ARTISTS' GROUP

2. An artist's signature on the entry form is an acknowledgement of responsibility of the professional presentation & enduring quality of the work for a minimum of 12 months.
3. Size Limitations: All categories, except Sculpture entries, are not to exceed 153cm in height and width (or equal area) including the frame and must not weigh more than 20kg. TRANSPORTING BY THE KONDININ ARTISTS' GROUP HAS A SIZE LIMITATION OF 1.2M X 800MM WHEN BOXED AND A WEIGHT LIMIT OF 20KGS.
4. A maximum of two entries per category will be accepted from each individual artist. Diptychs & triptychs to be entered as one piece.
5. The Kondinin Artists' Group Inc takes NO responsibility for any delivery or collection costs incurred.
6. Each entry shall be the original work of the artist & not copied in full or part thereof, from any production or published article. Works to have been completed within 1 year.
7. All entries will be eligible for pre-selection. No discussion or correspondence shall be entered into with any person regarding resultant selection or exhibition procedure.
8. The judges & organising committee reserve the right to reject any entry on the grounds that the material, subject, method, production or standard are considered unsuitable for the purpose of the exhibition. Entry fees cannot be refunded.
9. The committee in consultation with the judging panel, reserves the right not to award a prize. No correspondence will be entered into.
10. Insurance & any other considerations are the total responsibility of the exhibitor (artist) during the exhibition and transport of artwork.
11. All entries must be available for sale. A commission of 20% be charged on any artwork sold at the exhibition.
12. The Kondinin Artists' Group Inc may, after 1 month notification of intention dispose of or sell the work if the artist has failed to remove the exhibits as advised.
13. If the winning artists are registered for GST, the rate payable is 1/11th on cash prizes.
14. The winning entry for the Shire of Kondinin Acquisition Open Prize becomes the property of the Shire of Kondinin. Artists whose work is priced at more than \$7500.00 must specify if they will accept the prize money.

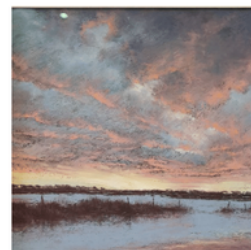

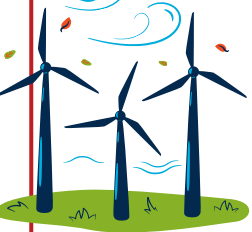

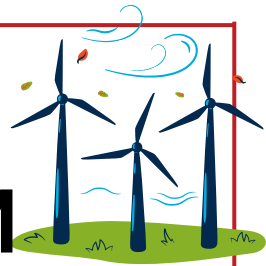

The local government has received an application to develop and use land for the following purpose and public comments are invited.

Lot Nos: Lot 2485 on DP 209641; Lot 2460 on DP 210252; Road Reserve Adjacent to Lot 2640 on DP 210252 and Lot 2485 on DP 209641.

Street: King Rocks Road North

Suburb: Hyden

Proposal: Synergy RED is seeking approval to undertake the King Rocks Wind Farm Project on the abovementioned lots adjacent to King Rocks Road North, Hyden. The project proposes to install a maximum 150MW wind farm comprising up to 30 wind turbines and associated infrastructure. The turbines will be installed on towers up to 150 metres tall with blades up to 90 metres long, delivering a total tip-height of up to 240 metres. The turbines will be supported by key infrastructure including access roads, transmission line, substation facilities and staff offices.

The Project will be established encompassing two freehold rural lots and adjacent road reserves comprising a total combined area of 3120 hectares.

This development application will be formally considered and determined by the Joint Development Assessment Panel (JDAP), an independent decision making body comprising technical experts and elected local government members.

Details of the proposal are available for inspection at the local government office in Hyden & Kondinin and on the Shire's website www.kondinin.wa.gov.au. Comments on the proposal may be submitted to the local government in writing on or before **Wednesday 21st September 2022**.

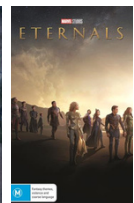

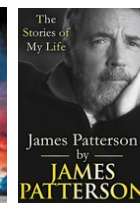
