






Kondinin Artists' Group

It is great to see the rain here and the start of the cropping season for our local farmers. We hope we have another successful year.

MARCH COUNCIL MEETING

At the March Ordinary Meeting, the following items were considered by Council:

- A local road near Kings Rocks was closed to allow for the future Wind Farm in the area. This will have no impact on local traffic.
- A proposal for the name changes of the Hyden and Districts
 Swimming Pool was considered with Council looking for feedback from the local public for the possible name change. The result from this will be presented back to Council for a final determination.
- A proposed Change to Vesting Order for the Hyden Recreation district was considered with Council also requesting boundary changes to reflect the current use of the land and facilities.
- An agreement for assistance with garden maintenance was approved by Council for the Hyden CWA. The Shire will be assisting the CWA by maintaining the gardens.
- An undertaking of amendments was approved by the Council for the Dogs Local Law 2022.
- An undertaking of amendments was approved by the Council for the Public Places and Local Government Property Local Law 2022.
- An undertaking of amendments was approved by the Council for the Bush Fire Brigades Local Law 2022.

- The 2022 Annual Compliance Return was presented to Council.
- The Annual Electors Meeting was considered by Council for any actions to be followed up on or any resolutions from the meeting.
- Council considered the 2023/2024 Road Works in preparation of the Annual Budget.
- Council also considered the longer term 10-year Road Works Program for forward planning of the Shire.

Anzac Biscuits



Prep: 15 Minutes



Cook: 15 Minutes



Ingredients

- 1 cup plain flour (all-purpose flour)
- 1 cup rolled oats.
- 1 cup desiccated coconut, unsweetened
- 3/4 cup white sugar, preferably caster / superfine
- 150g / 5oz unsalted butter
- 4 tbsp golden syrup (Note 1)
- 1 tsp baking soda (bicarbonate soda)



Method

- 1. Preheat oven to 180°C/350°F (160°C fan forced)
- 2. Line 2 baking trays with baking paper.
- 3. Mix flour, oats, coconut and sugar in a bowl.
- 4. Place butter and golden syrup in a saucepan over medium high heat and stir until butter has melted.
- 5. Add baking soda and stir to combine it will fizz up, this is normal. Immediately remove from heat.
- 6. Pour butter mixture into flour and mix until just combined.
- 7. Roll level 1 tablespoon mixture into balls, flatten into patties. Place balls, 2.5 cm/1" apart, on prepared trays.
- 8. Bake for 15 minutes, swapping trays halfway during cooking, or until deep golden. (Bake 12 min for chewy biscuits!)
- 9. Stand on trays for 5 minutes. Transfer to a wire rack to cool they harden as they cool!


