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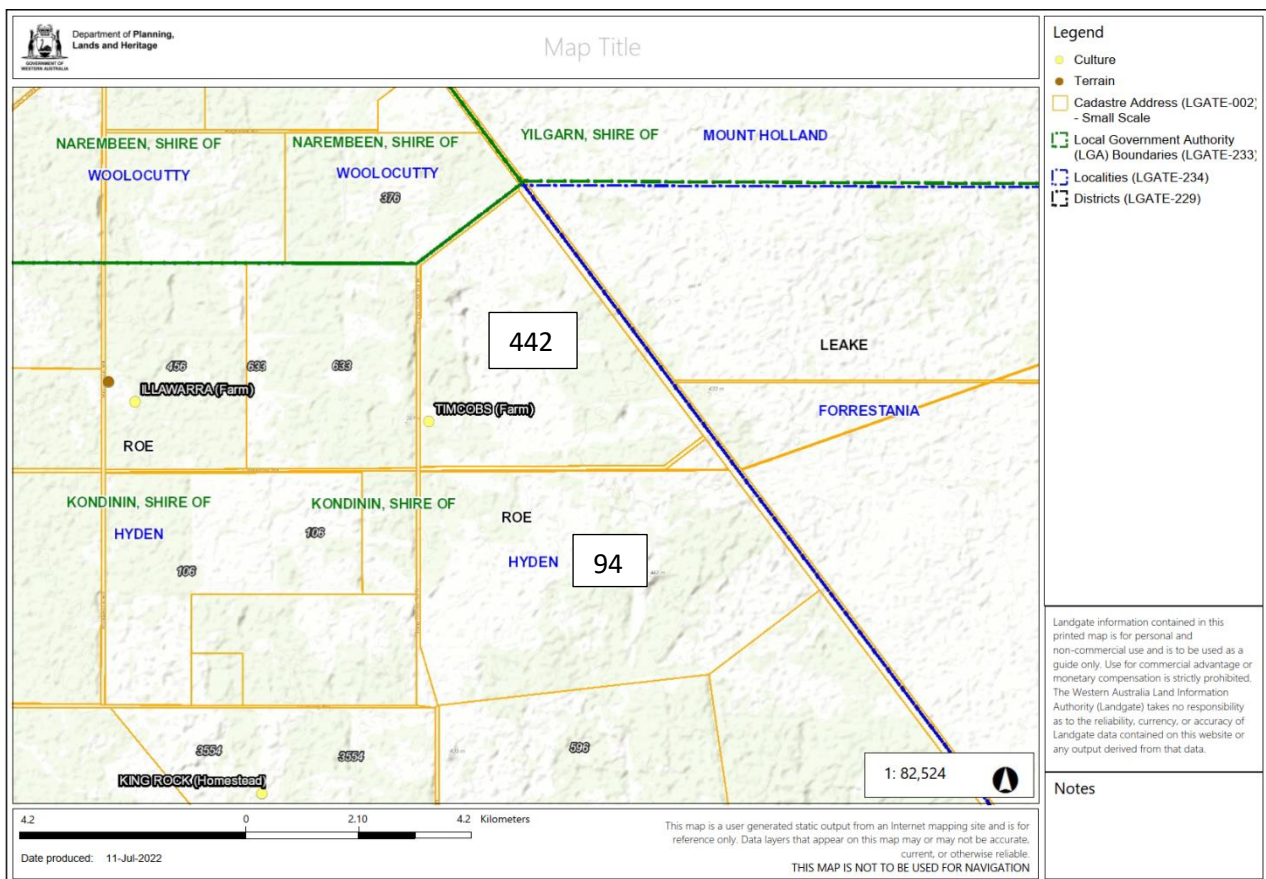

**94 & 42 Kings Rock Road North, Hyden, WA  
Kings Rock Windfarm  
European Heritage Assessment for Proposed Construction of Wind Farm**

As per your request, please find below a European Heritage Impact Desktop Assessment of the proposed Wind Farm works proposed to be located on 442 & 94 King Rocks Road North, Hyden WA 6359 and adjacent road reserves (site) as shown below.



**Map 1 – Proposed site location of Wind Farm on 442 & 94 King Rocks Road North, Hyden**

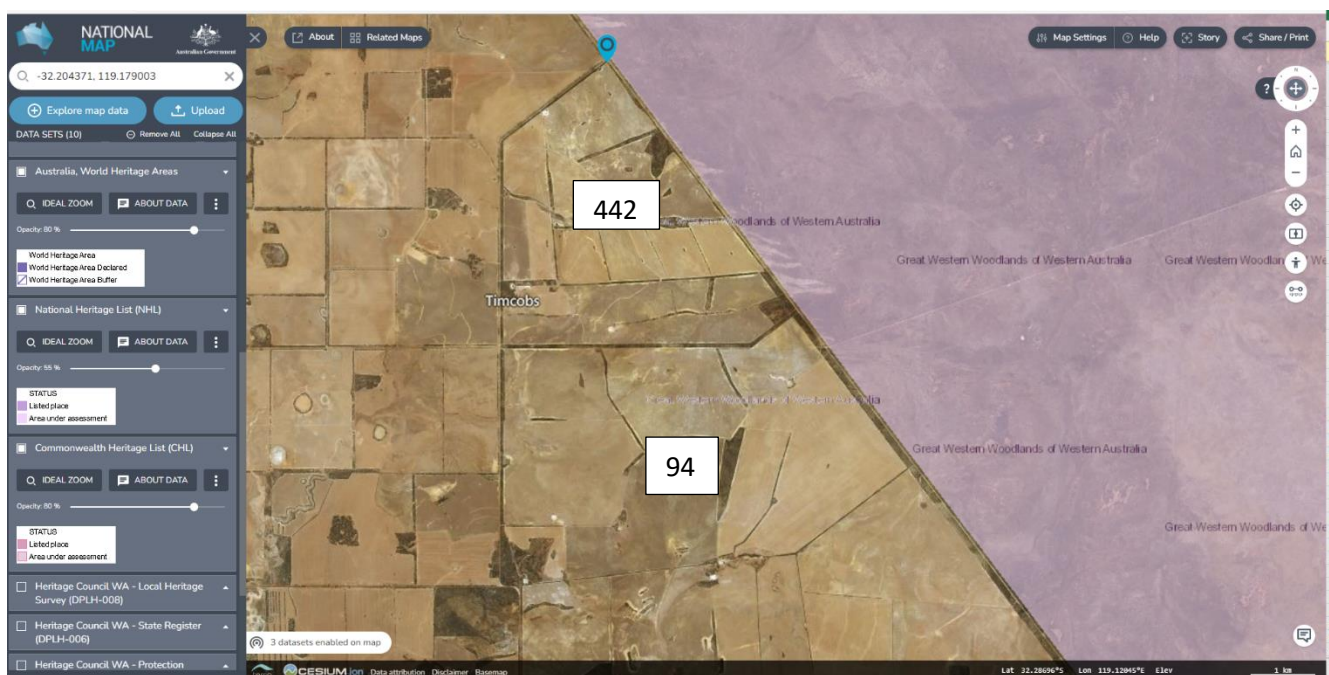
The Desktop Assessment is based on the advice from 360 Environmental that all infrastructure, other than access tracks and underground cabling, will be located 100 metres distance or greater from the Rabbit Proof Fence and that there is no construction machinery or equipment to be permitted within 10 metres of the Rabbit Proof Fence during construction or operations. The Assessment is assessed against the following Legislative Commonwealth and State Government Acts and assesses the below Heritage overlays.

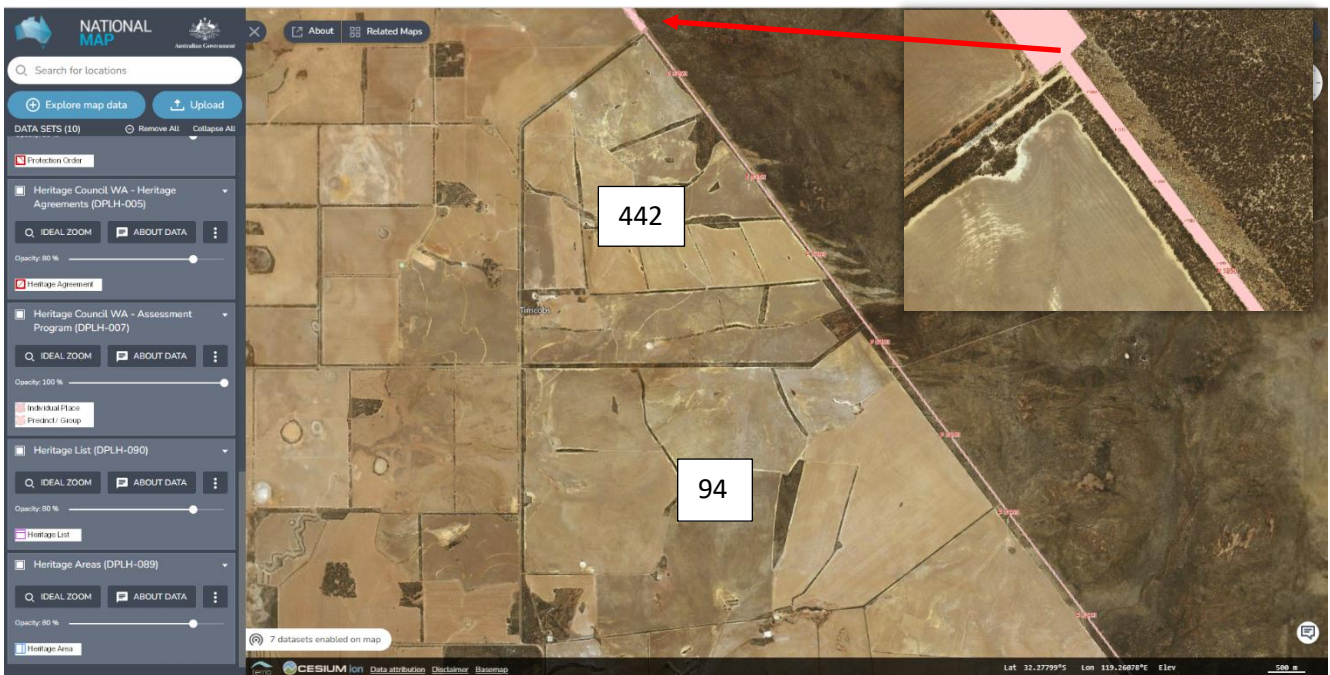

**Map 2 Assessment** - National Heritage List overlay (shown Purple) – Nominated Place – Place ID 106004 - Great Western Woodlands of Western Australia – as the overlay is a ‘Nominated Place’, the place is not listed on the Australian National Heritage List of the Department of Agriculture, Water and Environment (DAWE) website, hence the overlay is nil in effect. As the proposed works are setback from the Rabbit Proof Fence where the overlay curtilage overlays on the adjacent Lots to the East, it is further assessed that nil/negligible impact on the overlay curtilage area would be anticipated in the event the listing was added to the Heritage List. There are no World or Commonwealth listed areas within 200km of site, nor any other listed National Heritage Overlays.



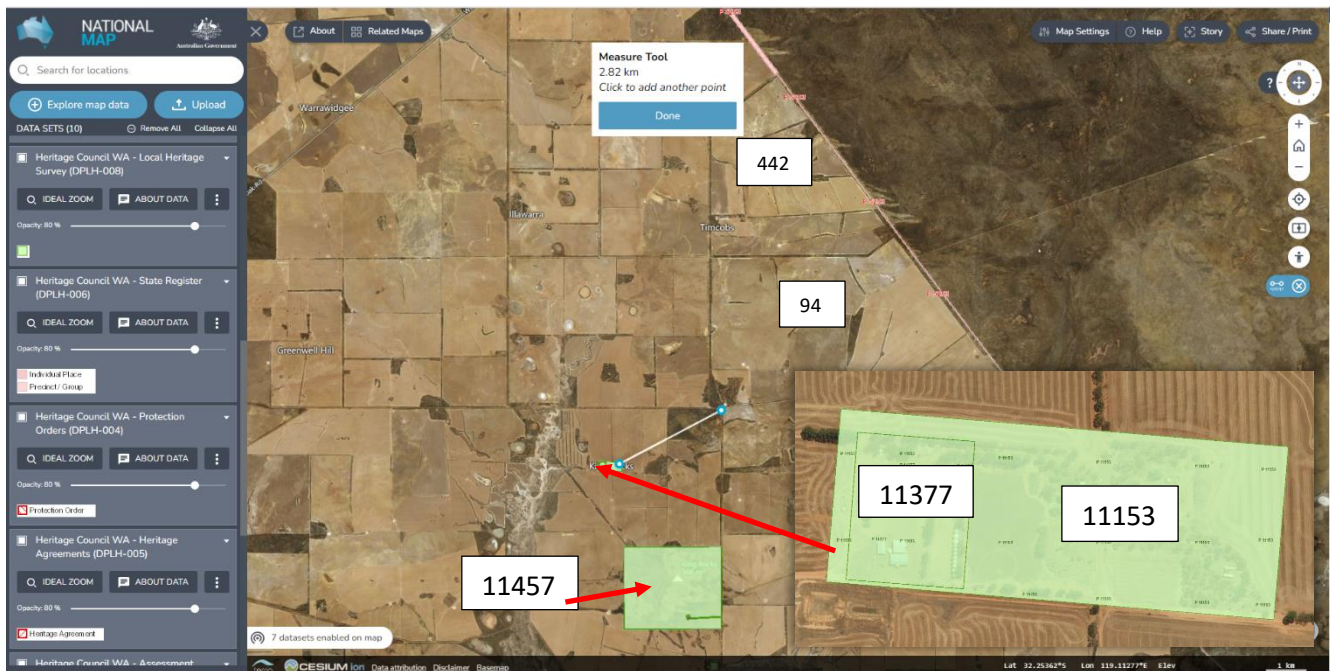
**Map 3 Assessment** – Heritage Council WA – Assessment Program Place (shown Pink along Eastern Boundary) – Place Number 5253 - Rabbit Proof Fence No 1 - Pt Hedland to Ravensthorpe – is not listed either as State or Local Heritage. The listing is listed ‘RHP 2005’ hence it is being considered for State Heritage listing. As the listing is not gazetted as per the Heritage Act 2018 requirements, the overlay has no legislative protective effect under The Heritage Act 2018 (WA). As the proposed works are setback over 100m from the Rabbit Proof Fence and no construction machinery or equipment will be located within 10 metres, it is further noted that nil/negligible impact on the overlaid area would be anticipated in the event the listing was gazetted.

It is also confirmed that there are no listed State Heritage sites within the vicinity of the site.

**Map 4 Assessment** – There are 3 Local Heritage listed sites located within 4km of the proposed works site of 94 & 442 King Rocks Road, the details are;

- Place No. 11153 - King Rocks Flying Doctor Service - Local Heritage Survey – located 2.82km from the southwest corner of 94 King Rocks Road North, the proposed works will have no impact of the heritage listing aspects of the place.
- Place No. 11377 - King Rocks Automatic Telephone Exchange - Local Heritage Survey – located 2.83km from the southwest corner of 94 King Rocks Road North, the proposed works will have no impact of the heritage listing aspects of the place.
- Place 11457 – King Rocks Dam Reserve – Local Heritage Survey - located 3.4km from the southwest corner of 94 King Rocks Road North, the proposed works will have no impact of the heritage listing aspects of the place.

The proposed wind farm works will have a negligible to nil impact on all Heritage listed items in the vicinity of the project works located within 442 & 94 King Rocks Road North, Hyden, WA. It is recommended when construction occurs the site management plan ensures no harm occurs to the Rabbit Proof Fence by mandating a setback of at least 10m from the fence line of all vehicle and other construction equipment, which has been advised will be implemented.

The above assessment is based on the assumption that all construction works take place within the property boundaries of on 442 & 94 King Rocks Road North, Hyden WA and adjacent road reserves inclusive of the minimal 10 metres works and equipment setback from the Rabbit Proof Fence and is based on typical Wind Farm design having not received a proposed site plan. If the proposed works vary from the above, the client should contact the author, a Town Planner, or a Heritage consultant for further advice.
