To completely assess situation will be a big job to remove pavers to access the tanks and the leach drains. As a way forward, the Shire Administration is investigating options to upgrade ladies' toilets and include disability access. Scope and plans to be prepared first. Initial meeting with draftsperson has been held on site. Varying opinions from Council and Community Members ranging from upgrades to existing toilets to the construction of a new toilet block linked to the hall. Administration awaiting further direction from Council to pursue this further. Matter was presented to Housing and Building Committee Meeting on the 24 July 2024 and 20 November 2024. Plans and costings have been received for a standalone new toilet block which was tabled for discussion at the next Housing and Building Committee Meeting in 2025 on the 12 February 2025.

Operational Summary – Recent Weeks 4-6

Operations & Staffing

Lucy has continued to excel in her role, maintaining a high standard of customer service and ensuring the facility is consistently well-presented. Her adherence to operational procedures has been outstanding, and day-to-day site operations remain stable with no issues requiring escalation.

Patron Attendance

Visitation has continued to build as community awareness and seasonal temperatures increase. Attendance over the past three weeks has been:

• Week 3: 92 patrons

• Week 4: 35 patrons

• Week 5: 67 patrons

These fluctuations reflect a combination of weather patterns, school commitments, and normal early-season variance. Overall, trends remain positive, with strong community engagement expected to grow as the season progresses.

Swim the Bight Challenge

Hyden patrons are now participating in the *Swim the Bight Challenge*, CAS's regional initiative where swimmers collectively track laps to "swim" the length of the Great Australian Bight.

The challenge is free to join and has already attracted interest from local swimmers. A live leaderboard tracks Hyden's progress against other Wheatbelt pools, encouraging friendly competition and promoting physical activity throughout the season.

The Mega Splash Events Calendar for the 2025–26 season will be released shortly. These events include:

- Music and entertainment days
- Fun, family-focused activities
