TOTAL FIRE BAN

A Total Fire Ban is declared by the Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES) on days when fires are most likely to threaten lives and property. This may be due to:

- · Predicted extreme fire weather
- · Limited firefighting resources available.

HOW TO FIND OUT IF THERE IS A TOTAL FIRE BAN?

There are several ways you can find out if a Total Fire Ban has been declared:

- Visit the Emergency WA website HERE.
- · Listen to ABC Local Radio.
- Call the DFES Total Fire Ban hotline on 1800 709 355.

ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED DURING A TOTAL FIRE BAN

- Some of the activities that are illegal to do during a Total Fire Ban, include:
- Lighting, maintaining or using a fire in the open air e.g. burning rubbish, fire pits
- Carrying out any activity in the open air that can cause or is likely to cause a fire e.g. welding, grinding, soldering, gas cutting and all forms of hot work
- Using a BBQ, smoker or cooker that uses solid fuel e.g. fire pits, Weber, pizza oven, smoker, kettle BBQ
- Using an internal combustion engine powered equipment in or near bush.
- Using vehicles including 4WD's, motor bikes, quad bikes or other motorised vehicles in the bush or paddocks, unless it is for the feeding or watering of stock.

A list of what you can and cannot do during a Total Fire Ban is available on the DFES website HERE.

EXEMPTIONS

Businesses are required to obtain a Total Fire Ban Exemption for any activity not prescribed within the Bush Fires Regulations 1954, which could cause or is likely to cause a fire. These activities include fireworks, programmed hot fire training, rail grinding, and religious and cultural ceremonies. Information for business and industry can be found HERE.

HARVEST VEHICLE MOVEMENT BAN

In accordance with the Bush Fire Regulations 1954 (r.24C and r.38A) the Shire of Kondinin Chief Bushfire Control Officer (CBFCO) has the ability to impose a ban on the use or operation of any engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery in the area. This is for the purpose of restricting activities that are likely to cause a bushfire or contribute to the spread of a bushfire when the expected weather condition indicates that if a wildfire was to start it would be dangerous, destructive and difficult to stop once started.

This ban is commonly referred to as a Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban (HVMB).

There are two types of HVMBs:

- During a Total Fire Ban (r.24C) when the Fire Behaviour Index (FBI) reaches or exceeds 40, banning off-road, harvesting and agricultural activities.
- During Restricted and Prohibited Burning Periods (r.38A) at the discretion of the CBFCO, banning any
 activity (as determined by the Shire) in its entirety or additional conditions can be imposed not specific
 to vegetated land.

Further information about recent changes to the Australian Fire Danger Rating System (AFDRS) and FBI's can be found **HERE**.

ACTIVITIES THAT MAY BE BANNED DURING A HVMB

Subject to the type of HVMB declared by the Shire of Kondinin (24C or 38A), the following activities may be banned:

- · Off-road activities
- Harvesting operations and agriculture activities
- Use or operation of any engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery in the area likely to cause a bushfire or contribute to the spread of a bushfire (eg. motorbikes, quad bikes or other motorised vehicles in bush or off-road areas including paddocks).

ACTIVITIES THAT ARE ALLOWED DURING A HVMB

- Movement of vehicles on "gazetted roads" as described in Bush Fires regulation 24A(1) and Road Traffic Act 1974 section 5.1.
- Movement of vehicles on a lane, driveway, yard or other areas that provide access to, or a parking facility at, any residential, farming or business premises, if the site has been sufficiently cleared of inflammable material to prevent the escape of fire.
- Use or operation of a vehicle if it is for the prevention of an immediate and severe risk to the health or safety of a person or livestock, and only if all reasonable precautions have been taken to prevent the activity from creating a bushfire danger.



NOVEMBER MEETING

At the November Council Meeting, several items were presented to Council. This included:

- The tender for the upgrades to the Hyden Swimming Pool change rooms was accepted and works will be commencing soon.
- Proposed refurbishments for the Kondinin Pavilion were endorsed.
 This work will be considered in the 2022-2023 Budget.
- An update on the recent Heritage Survey was presented to Council including the Draft Survey.
- An update on works for the Community Water Supply Program and funding was presented. This is looking at additional water resources for dryer years.
- Consideration of extended trading for the Christmas/Harvest season was considered and an application prepared to the Department of Commerce.
- A reallocation of the Community
 Grants for the Kondinin Swimming
 Club was considered as the original
 lane ropes were no longer able to
 be purchased. This will now go
 towards sun smart items.

ROADWORKS

Our Road Sealing programme is progressing with works on the Secondary Freight Route of the Kondinin-Narembeen Road.

Other Works will include: Karlgarin-Lake Grace Road is to be sealed. Patch grading has now been undertaken and will continue through the harvest period, with gravel being carted to some of the major blowouts where possible.

COMMUNITY SURVEYS AND FEEDBACK

REVIEW OF COUNCILLORS REPRESENTATION Discussion Paper

As part of the Local Government Reforms process, the Shire of Kondinin has been requested by the Minister for Local Government to reduce our Councillor numbers from 9 to 7. This can either be through a voluntary process or forced by the Department through legislation.

Choc and Chia Pudding

Total Time: 2 hours 5 mins Prep; 5 mins















- 1 tbsp maple syrup or honey
- ½ cup of low fat milk
- 1/3 cup chia seeds
- 2tsp of cocoa powder
- 2 cups of fresh or frozen berries



Method

- 1. Pour the maple syrup or honey in a 500ml capacity jar that comes with a lid.
- 2. Add some milk to the container and close it. Shake well till the syrup is completely dissolved.
- 3. Now pour the remaining milk to into the jar. Also add the chia seeds and cocoa powder.
- 4. Shake again and now pour the mixture in 4 small serving glasses
- 5. Cover and refrigerate for at least 2 hours. Keep overnight for best results.
- 6. Serve chilled topped with berries
- Tip: For dairy-free alternative, switch dairy milk with your favourite alterative such as soy almond or coconut milk.


