# An update on the progress of the HYDEN VISITOR CENTRE

In 2017 the Hyden CRC and the Shire of Kondinin started discussion about a change of location for the CRC that would give more visual access to assist with the viability of the Centre. At about the same time, the Hyden Progress Association started discussions to look at the possibility of "Woodlands Discovery Centre" for Hyden.

In 2018 the Hyden Progress Association bought the block of land west of the IGA carpark, corner of McPherson & Marshall Street, with the intention of working with the Shire of Kondinin and the Community Resource Centre to construct a multipurpose iconic building that would suit the requirements of the various projects.

In 2020 Caroline Robinson (150Square) was engaged by the Shire of Kondinin to assist in documenting the key thoughts regarding the purpose of the building in the Hyden Community, Shire of Kondinin and surrounding areas.

Architects were employed to put forward concept drawings, and the Kondinin Shire applied for funding from the Building Better Regions Fund. They were unsuccessful in Round 5 and due to a technicality did not submit an application in Round 6. With a change of Government the funding no longer exists, but the Labor Government have introduced a 'Growing Better Regions Fund' though little detail being released up to this point.

It is proposed that the building will house the Hyden Community Resource Centre, some Shire offices, the Library together with Visitor Information. There will be room for some commercial businesses and a Discovery Centre, with displays and promotion of surrounding tourist attractions, together with displays and videos of the Hyden and Districts history.

We are also investigating options for the current Hyden Community Resource Centre building.

Over the best part of the last 12 months little progress has been made due to lack of funding and the main focus being the Hyden Centenary. During this time, additional information has been sought to strengthen the business case for the Centre and advocacy for consideration of other funding sources. Now that the Centenary is finished the Hyden Progress Association has decided to restart the process of pushing this project for the region.

On December 22nd 2022 a meeting was convened of the Working Group which is made up of key stakeholders who are vested in the building, as well as community members, to decide where we go from here.

I was co-opted onto the Working Group and elected as Chairman at that meeting. Monique Brown & Davina Biglin were elected as Joint Secretary and Steph Whitwell Minute Secretary.

Other members of the Working Group are:

- David Burton - Kondinin Shire CEO, Paul & Kerrie Green – Kondinin Shire Councillors, Josh Whitwell – HPA President, Tyron Utley – HPA Secretary, Gerard Lynch, Catherine Mayfield, Sharon Hinck & Steve Jones.

Since that meeting, Michael Ward has been co-opted onto the Working Group.

Another meeting of the Working Group was held on February 9th2023. Tasks that have been initiated are:-

- 1. Research for various funding sources including Federal and State funding. We are conscious of the Hyden Sports Council projects being considered and want to source a majority of our funds from avenues that are unlikely to fund a Sports Council Project.
- 2. Amend the timeline for the project.
- 3. Decide on a name for the building. There doesn't seem to be any appetite amongst the Working Group to keep the name Hyden Visitors Centre.

# An update on the progress of the HYDEN VISITOR CENTRE -Continued

Suggestions put forward thus far are:- Hyden Heart, Wave Rock Discovery Centre, Wave Rock Cultural Discovery Centre.

The majority of the Working Group were of the view that as Wave Rock is a world renowned tourist attraction that the words 'Wave Rock' should be in the name.

We invite members of the community to submit their ideas for a name that encompasses the vision for the building. It has been proposed that at the next Working Group meeting on March 30th we narrow the number of suggested names down to three. We will then survey the community to determine the most popular name.



# UPGRADES TO HYDEN SWIMMING POOL CHANGE ROOMS

In January 2023 works commenced upgrading the Hyden Swimming Pool Change Rooms comprising a new roof over the existing building structure and a new internal fit-out to the change rooms. The change rooms have been gutted. Plumbing and works to the roof commenced. Works are on track to be completed by April / May 2023. This project is being funded by the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Phase 3 Grant funding through the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts.

With the building being rendered and new signage being prepared, the Council resolved at its Ordinary Meeting on the 15th of March 2023 to seek community feedback on the proposal to rename the Hyden Swimming Pool from 'Hyden and Districts Swimming Pool' to 'Hyden Aquatic Centre'. # **RE-SURFACE OF HYDEN TENNIS COURTS**

Works have commenced with the re-surfacing of the Hyden Tennis Courts and Hotshots / Bumper Board courts and associated drainage works, with the Hyden community undertaking a busy bee on the 9th of March 2023 to remove the old surface. It was all hands on deck and was completed quicker than expected due to all the helpers and coordination of those involved. Drainage works commenced during the week beginning the 13th of March 2023 to be followed up with a new bumper board and lastly the laying of the new surface anticipated to be undertaken in May 2023. The removal of some of the trees on the northern and eastern sides of the tennis courts is scheduled to be undertaken this week.

This project has been made possible through the dedication and commitment of the Hyden Tennis Club who have been the main driver behind this project and have committed 1/3 of the total cost of works. The Shire of Kondinin were successful in receiving 1/6 of the cost of works (\$44, 169) being the maximum that could be received for re-surfacing through the Department of Local Government Sport and Cultural Industries Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Fund with the remainder of the cost of the project being covered by the Shire.

A big thank you to all the helpers at the busy bee.

# **Proposed Fencing Local Law**

The Shire of Kondinin proposes to adopt a Fencing Local Law – Purpose – to prescribe sufficient fences, the standard for construction of fences and create offences for non-compliance.

Effect – to establish the minimum requirements for fencing, provide for permitted and prohibited fencing, and create offences for non-compliance.

# **One-Pan Carbonara**

Prep: 5 Minutes

Cook: 20 Minutes

## Ingredients


- 250g pappardelle
- 3/4 cup cooking cream
- 100g parmesan, finely grated 3 free range egg yolks
- 250g middle bacon rasher, rind removed, roughly chopped 2/3 cup frozen peas,
- 2 thyme springs, to serve

## Serves: 4

### Method

- 1. Fill a large, deep frying pan with water until two-thirds full. Bring to the boil over medium-high heat. Add pasta and cook for 7 minutes or until tender. Drain, reserving 1/2 cup cooking liquid.
- 2. Meanwhile, whisk cream, two-thirds of the parmesan and egg yolks in a small bowl.
- 3. Heat oil in same frying pan over medium-high heat. Cook bacon for 5 minutes, stirring, or until browned. Add peas and cook for 1 minute or until peas are tender.


