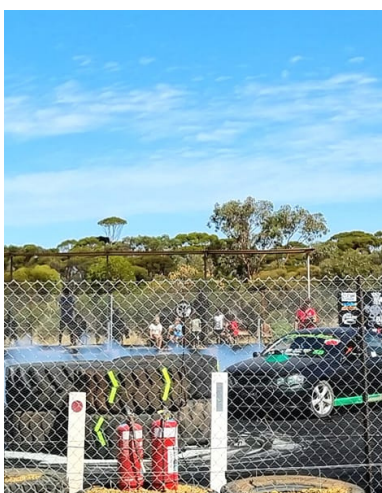

COMMUNITY GRANT 2023/2024

Thank you to all the community groups who submitted applications. A resolution from Council has been made at the Ordinary Meeting of Council on the 17th of May 2023 to confirm funding allocation in the 2023/2024 financial year.

CEO CORNER

Most may be aware, but we wanted to ensure as many get the message as possible that SOCK Week (Save Our Country Kids) will be happening from 26th to 30th June.

SOCK week will see engaging and fun events that promote several road safety messages such as drink driving, speeding, distractions and fatigue and is aimed at a broad cross-section of the community.

Our CRC's will be very busy with events to promote safety awareness and we encourage all residents to participate.

MAY COUNCIL MEETING

At the May Ordinary Meeting, the following items were considered by Council:

- The proposal to close a public road and incorporate into freehold land for Lot 2640 and Lot 2485 King Rocks Road.
- The proposal to close a part of a local Public Road Reserve along Marshall Street Hyden for the purpose of an Electric Vehicle Charging Station
- Consideration of the changing of the name of the Hyden and Districts Swimming Pool.
- Draft Fees and Charges for the 2023/2024 Financial Year
- Differential Rates proposed for the 2023/2024 Financial Year were discussed for advertising.
- Consideration of financial assistance for Hyden/Kondinin St John's Ambulance for the construction of the Hyden Centre.

- A new Policy was adopted for Habitual or Vexatious Complainants allowing staff to take action against such issues
- A Change to the Delegated Authority of the CEO was made to give the administration staff a little more flexibility and reduce administration impacts.
- The Shire confirmed its support for the 2023 Kondinin Arts Acquisition Prize
- The Shire of Kondinin is working with the Shire of Kulin to formalise an MOU for shared medical services to our towns. This will be finalised when the new Doctor has had a chance to settle in.
- A correction was required on a previously made resolution as an incorrect Assessment Number had been used in the resolution.

CEO SHIFTING TO HYDEN

Due to housing requirements for the new Doctor, the Shire has been caught short on housing for the CEO. As an interim measure, housing has been secured in Hyden and the CEO will be shifting shortly.

The Shire will be considering housing as part of the 2023/2024 Annual Budget.

UP AND COMING RATES SEASON

As we are nearing the new Financial Year, we would like to remind our Ratepayers that the rate notices will be sent out shortly after the adoption of the Annual Budget.

The due date for the rate is normally towards the end of September and please be mindful of the cut-off for claiming the discount.

Please take care that correct information is provided when paying your rates through EFT, otherwise, staff cannot allocate the payment to your account!

If you are experiencing difficulty in paying your annual rates, please contact the Rates Officer as soon as possible and payment arrangements may be able to be offered to reduce the burden of the rates notice. The sooner this can be arranged, the easier it can be. All information relating to ratepayers on payment arrangements is kept strictly confidential.

Healthier Beef Stroganoff

Prep: 5 Minutes


Cook: 20 Minutes


Serves: 4

Ingredients

- 1 quarters cup self-raising flour
- 200 grams cup mushrooms, sliced
- 1 half cup fresh parsley leaves, roughly torn (plus extra to serve)
- 1 cup salt-reduced beef stock
- 1 half cup Greek style yoghurt
- 1 half teaspoon ground black pepper
- 2 tablespoon dijon mustard
- 500 grams simply steam zucchini spaghetti
- 500 grams beef stir- fry
- 2 teaspoon olive oil
- 1 teaspoon garlic paste
- 1 cup baby frozen peas
- 4 wholemeal rolls, warmed until crusty in the oven



Method

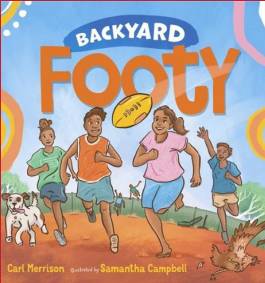
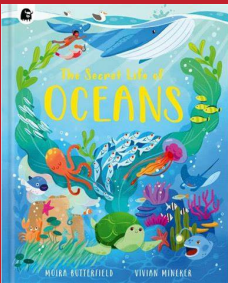
1. Coat the beef in the flour. Heat a large frying pan with 1 tbs of olive oil, coating the bottom. Brown the beef in the hot pan with the garlic.
2. Add the stock, mushrooms, peas and Dijon mustard. Cook for 5 minutes until starting to bubble, then turn down the heat and add 1/2 cup of water.
3. Simmer for 20 minutes. Chop the parsley.
4. Turn off the heat and fold through the yoghurt, black pepper and parsley.
5. Steam the zucchini zoodles in the microwave according to instructions.
6. Assemble the meal by plating up the zucchini noodles and topping with the beef and pea stroganoff. Serve with a warm, crusty bread roll and extra parsley.
