During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

Do you live in or near Brookton, Corrigin, Dalwallinu, Katanning, Kondinin, Kulin, Moora or Wongan Hills?

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or more students for three nights, be able to assist with transporting them to/from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students.

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life.






Warmer weather is certainly here and I am sure we are all enjoying the sunshine. Just remember that snakes are now out and about as well.

October/November Council Meetings

At the October Ordinary Meeting, the following items were considered by Council:

- Council approved some upgrades to Kondinin North CBH Grain Receival site for more open storage bulkhead area.
- Council approved some upgrades to Hyden CBH Grain Receival site for more open storage bulkhead area.
- Council approved a development application for a machinery shed on Lot 802 on the Hyden-Lake King Road.
- License to Access Agreements between the Shire and CBH was approved for access to the Kondinin North Receival site and Hyden CBH Receival site for water access.
- Council resolved to purchase Lot 151 on Radbourne Drive, Hyden for future housing for the Shire.
- Council will be proceeding with the process of selling some land with outstanding rates.
- Council has changed the policy of subsidising electricity accounts for Sporting Clubs and amenities
- Items of the WALGA AGM were considered at Council.
- A report for items at the Wave Rock Septic Pond were considered with the request for a further report on corrective measures.

A Special Meeting was held on 1st November the following items were considered by Council:

- Election of President
- Election of Deputy President
- Items of equipment requested by Doctor

At the November Ordinary Meeting, the following items were considered by Council:

- Council supported the proposed subdivision of Lots 802 and 192 in Hyden
- An item to consider the transfer of Water Corp pipeline at McCann's Rock Road to the Shire was allowed to remain on the table for more information to be sought.
- Council approved paying Swimming Club affiliation fees for the town Swimming Clubs to encourage people to learn to swim better.
- A small amount of Rates was written off an assessment due to a banking error that stopped the payment.
- Updated information on the Discovery Centre was provided.
- The Corporate Business Plan quarterly report was accepted by Council
- The Shire of Kondinin Workforce Plan was endorsed by Council
- Council agreed to extend the CEO contract for a further five years.
- Council has agreed to continue working with our neighbouring Shires with RoeROC.
- Council has agreed to continue to be a part of the RoeROC Health Scheme for shared services of an EHO.
- Council will be looking at finishing the Mural project in Hyden and have allocated funding to the project.

CBH have qualified snake handlers and catchers. If you find a scaley friend in your house or yard you can call **0419 232 951 (Sam)** and I can get one of our team members to you to remove the snake safely. I have handlers in **Corrigin area, Kulin area and Kondinin Shire area** over the harvest period. We are happy to offer this service to the community no charge.

If you do come across a snake please call and we can help. We do ask that you keep track of the snake as they don't remain in one spot and we can't spend all day looking for them.

Works currently in progress

The Works Crew are currently fixing issues from the recent storm that passed through our Shire damaging several roads.

The crew will also be looking at going through the Karlgarin Townsite to tidy up after the storm as soon as possible.

Council Elections

As most may be aware, Council elections were completed in October this year.

The Ordinary Election saw the return of Cr Darren Pool, Cr Bev Gangell and Cr Murray James to Council.

Due to the State Government Local Government Reforms, only 3 Council Members were able to be selected this year.

The Shire would like to thank Tom Mulcahy for his dedication and years of service to the community and the Shire.

At a Special Council Meeting held on 1st November, Cr Kent Mouritz was elected unopposed to the role of Shire President and Cr Bev Gangell elected to the role of Deputy Shire President unopposed.

The objectives of the program are to:

Beef, honey-glazed veg and soba noodle bowl



Total Time: 25 Minutes



Serves: 4



Ingredients

- 190g soba noodles
- 1 tbsp mirin
- 1 tbsp rice wine vinegar
- 1 tbsp honey
- 1 tsp finely grated fresh ginger
- 1 tbsp coconut oil
- 500g beef steaks (scotch fillet, sirloin or rump)
- 1 bunch small radishes, quartered
- 400g small brussels sprouts, halved
- 2 tsp mixed sesame seeds
- Green shallots, shredded, to serve

Dressing

- 1 tbsp tamari
- 2 tsp mirin
- 1 tsp sesame oil
- 1 tsp honey
- 1 tsp finely grated fresh ginger

Method

Step 1

Cook noodles in a large saucepan of boiling water following packet directions until tender. Drain and rinse under cold running water.

Step 2

Meanwhile, to make the dressing, combine all ingredients in a bowl. Set aside.

Step 3

Combine mirin, vinegar, honey and ginger in a bowl. Heat 1 tsp coconut oil in a large non-stick frying pan over medium-high heat. Season steak. Cook, turning, for 5 minutes for medium or until cooked to your liking. Transfer to a plate. Cover and set aside.

Step 4

Heat remaining oil in pan over medium-high heat. Add the radish and sprouts. Season. Cook, stirring, for 6 minutes or until golden brown. Add mirin mixture. Cook, stirring, for 2 minutes or until glazed and sticky. Stir in half the sesame. Remove from heat.

Step 5

Thinly slice steak. Divide the noodles among serving bowls. Top with radish mixture and steak. Drizzle with dressing and sprinkle with shallot and remaining sesame.


