SNAP SEND SOLVE

INCREASE WATER STORAGE AND ACCESS IN KARLGARIN & HYDEN

Through funding from the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation and as a recipient of the State Government's Community Water Supplies Partnership Program, the Shire of Kondinin have been able to increase the storage and access to community water supplies in Karlgarin and Hyden. This has comprised a new 275KL tank and swipe card controller at the former cricket oval on McCann's Rock Road, Karlgarin to supplement the existing swipe card controller at the end of McCann's Rock Road; a new 275KL tank adjacent to the tap outlet at Karlgarin C site (Want Road, Karlgarin) to supplement the existing concrete 782KL tank at the site; a new 275KL storage tank and associated generator set and pump at Karlgarin Dam to increase storage and access to water from this site; and a generator set and pump at the dam to the south of the bulkheads within the Hyden CBH site and a solar pump to replace the old diesel pump at the smaller holding dam at the Hyden CBH site, to improve the efficiency in the capture and storage of water to reticulate the Hyden Sporting Precinct.

Please note for McCann's Rock Tank you will need a swipe card to access water from the new controller. This is the same swipe card that is issued for all other community water supply sites in the Shire of Kondinin.

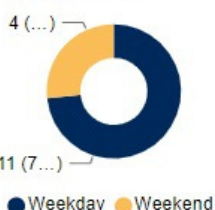

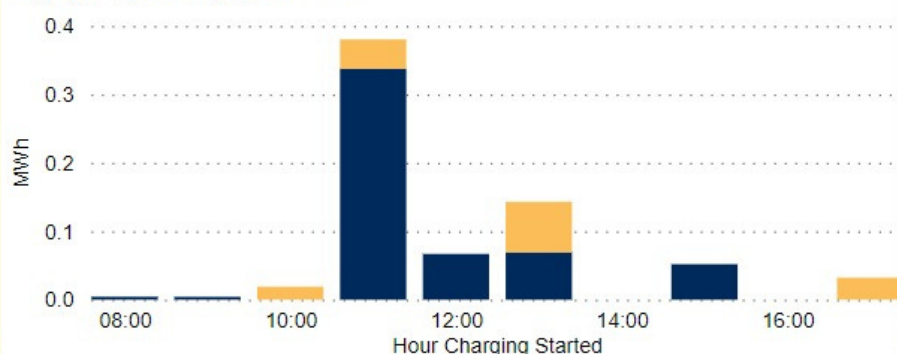

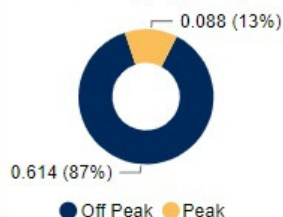

For the February Ordinary Council Meeting, the following was discussed:

- A Lease Agreement between the Shire of Kondinin CRC was confirmed.
- An easement at McCanns Rock for water services is to be transferred to the Shire.
- Consideration of options for the Hyden Tennis Club Building Roof.
- Consideration of the proposed new building at the Karlgarin Bowling Club

BBQ Lamb Wraps



Time: 55Minutes



Serves: 4



Ingredients

- 2 cups (270g) Red Tractor Protein Paleo Flour Blend
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp salt
- 400ml coconut milk
- 1/2 red onion, very thinly sliced
- 2 tbs lemon juice
- 250g cherry tomatoes
- 4 lamb leg steaks
- 1 tsp ground cumin
- 1 tsp ground paprika
- 2 baby cos lettuce, leaves torn
- 1 avocado, stoned, peeled, thinly sliced
- Mint leaves, to serve
- Lemon wedges, to serve

Method

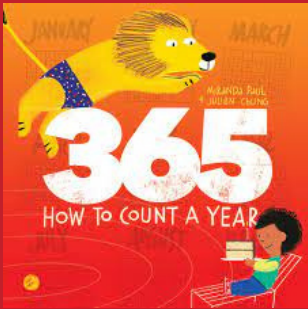
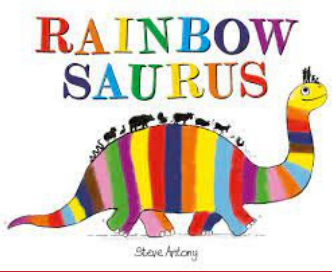
- Step 1
Combine the **flour**, **baking powder** and **salt** in a large bowl. Add the **coconut milk** and stir until well combined. Divide the dough into 8 even portions. Roll out 1 portion on a sheet of baking paper to a 20cm disc. Heat a large heavy-based frying pan over medium-high heat and spray with olive oil spray. Cook the wrap for 1 1/2 mins or until lightly charred. Spray with olive oil spray and turn. Cook for a further 1 1/2 mins or until lightly charred and cooked through. Transfer the wrap to a clean tea towel and cover to keep warm. Repeat with the remaining dough portions to make 8 wraps.
- Step 2
Combine the **onion** and **lemon juice** in a small bowl. Heat the frying pan over medium-high heat. Add the **tomatoes** and cook for 3 mins or until tomatoes begin to collapse. Transfer to a plate.
- Step 3
Sprinkle the **lamb** with the **cumin** and **paprika**. Heat a lightly greased barbecue grill or chargrill on high. Cook lamb for 3-4 mins each side for medium or until cooked to your liking. Transfer lamb to a plate. Cover with foil and set aside for 5 mins to rest. Thickly slice.
- Step 4
Drain the onion. Divide wraps among serving plates. Top with **lettuce**, lamb, tomatoes, **avocado** and onion. Sprinkle with **mint** and serve with **lemon wedges**.
