LOCAL ROADS AND COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE PHASE 3 FUNDING

With the completion of the new concrete pathway from the Hyden Swimming Pool Car Park to the Youth Base; the replacement shade sails at the Hyden and Kondinin Swimming Pools and the near completion of new fencing around the perimeter of the Hyden Tennis Courts and Hotshots Courts and new fencing on the southern boundary of the Hyden Hockey Field this phase of funding will be completed within the prescribed timeframe of the 30th June 2024. Other completed projects that were undertaken as part of this round of Federal Government funding to a total of \$1,086,468 included: replacement ceiling at the Hyden Golf Club, bin enclosures in the 3 town sites; upgrades to the Hyden Swimming Pool Change Rooms; Asphalting of the Hyden Swimming Pool Car Park and CCTV cameras installed around some of the Shire's key public buildings and places.



HYDEN RAILWAY BARRACKS RELOCATION COMPLETED

Through funding from the Shire of Kondinin and contributions from the Hyden Progress Association, the Hyden Railway Barracks has been successfully relocated to its new position along Marshall Street, Hyden. A shout out to Kerrie Green and the Hyden Progress Association and to Roger Northey for all their work on this project. The building has certainly gained a new lease on life and provides another place of interest to complement the scrap art sculpture display area adjacent to the railway line.



WATER MANAGEMENT PROJECTS

Through funding from the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation the Shire have undertaken a number of improvements to its community water supplies recently including; a new 270KL holding tank and associated outlets at Karlgarin C site, repair works to King Rocks dam wall; new solar pump at Hyden CBH holding dam; new submersible pump and associated generator set at Hyden CBH overflow dam; new submersible pump and associated generator set at Karlgarin Dam; catchment management surrounding the Karlgarin Dam; and a new 270KL tank and associated standpipe controller at the former oval at McCann's Rock. Please note that a swipe card is required to obtain water from this new community water supply.

KONDININ COMMUNITY GARDEN

The Kondinin Community Garden was established in 2015 by the Shire in close collaboration with a core group of local volunteers. Through assistance from volunteers, grant funding, donations and financial contributions from the Shire the space has continued to develop into an attractive and engaging public space well used by the community.

Sadly in recent times the garden is being badly mistreated with play equipment being damaged, fruit not yet ripened being picked and scattered over the garden, lights left on, rubbish left lying around and toilet paper and paper towels being stuffed into toilets.

This is a community space for everyone which the Shire does not wish to see locked up.

We ask that all patrons to the Community Garden respect the efforts of those that have worked so hard to create the space and made it what it is today.



As a guide coming into the school holidays it is asked that patrons consider the following when visiting the garden:

- 1. All rubbish to be placed in the bins provided
- 2. Venue not to be used after dark unless for a booked event
- 3. Fruit and vegetables to be picked sparingly and only if ripe
- 4. Parents are responsible for the safety and supervision of their children
- 5. Sink, bench and pizza oven to be used for real food preparation only, not play
- 6. Playing with sand to be kept to the nature play area
- 7. Toilets to be used primarily for booked events only



ROAD WORK UPDATE

The Shire works crew have been busy recently completing the resleaing and reconstrution of sections of the East Hyden Bin Road via funding from through Phase 4 of the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure grant; the completion of gravel sheeting on Bates Road to the Humps, Hyden; winter maintence grading over the south-east section of the Shire; completion of the Hyden-Lake King Road intersection in collboration with Main Road contractors, Fulton Hogan; gravel sheeting along Sedgewick Road, Hyden in progress to be completed shortly; the completion of 4.5km of gravel sheeting along the Forrestaina Marvel Rock Road, Hyden as private works for the mines; and work has commenced on the remaining 5km of the 20km seal of the Hyden-Norseman Road which the Shire received funding of \$4 million from the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications through the Remote Roads Upgrade Pilot Program.



- An easement was approved for the McCanns Rock Pipeline.
- The proposed Differential Rates for the 2024/25 Budget were approved.
- An update on the Discovery Centre was presented.
- Selection of Members attending and voting rights for WALGA LG Week Conference were considered.

Classic shepherd's pie



Total Time: 1hr 15mins





Ingredients

- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 brown onion, halved, finely chopped
- 1 carrot, peeled, finely chopped
- 2 celery sticks, trimmed, finely chopped
- 500g <u>lamb mince</u>
- 2 tbsp plain flour
- 1 tbsp Coles Tomato Paste

Method

• Step 1

Heat oil in a large saucepan over medium-high heat. Add onion, carrot and celery and cook, stirring, for 5 minutes or until soft. Add lamb mince and cook, stirring to break up any lumps, for 5 minutes or until lamb changes colour.

• Step 2

Add the flour and cook, stirring, for 2 minutes or until combined. Add tomato paste, Worcestershire sauce, bay leaf and stock. Bring to the boil. Reduce heat to low and cook, stirring occasionally, for 30 minutes or until sauce thickens. Taste and season.

- 1 tbsp worcestershire sauce
- 1 bay leaf
- 500ml (2 cups) Massel beef style stock
- 4 (about 200g each) desiree potatoes, peeled, chopped
- 40g butter
- 125ml (1/2 cup) milk
- Melted butter, to brush

Step 3

Meanwhile: cook potato in a saucepan of salted boiling water for 15 minutes or until tender. Drain well. Return to the pan with the butter. Use a potato masher or fork to mash until smooth. Add milk and use a wooden spoon to stir until combined. Taste and season with salt and pepper.

• Step 4


Preheat oven to 200C. Spoon lamb mixture into a 2L (8-cup) capacity ovenproof baking dish, or use four individual ovenproof serving dishes. Top with mashed potato and use a fork to spread over lamb mixture. Brush with butter. Bake in preheated oven for 20 minutes or until mashed potato is golden brown. Serve immediately


