



One-pan Pesto Chicken Pasta







<u>Ingredients</u>

- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 500 g boneless, skinless chicken breasts, diced
- 1 tsp sea salt flakes, plus extra to taste
- ½ tsp cracked black pepper, plus extra to taste
- 2½ tbsp unsalted butter
- 1 tbsp freshly minced garlic
- 3 cups (750 ml) chicken stock
- 1½ cups (375 ml) thickened (heavy) cream
- 250 g (9 oz) short pasta
- 1 head of broccoli
- 2 tbsp pesto, store-bought or homemade
- 1 cup (100 g) freshly grated parmesan
- Fresh basil leaves, to serve

Instructions

- 1) Heat the olive oil in a large, heavy-based frying pan over medium-high heat. Add the chicken, salt and pepper. Cook, stirring, for 3–5 minutes until the chicken is just cooked through. Set aside.
- 2) Add the butter and, once melted, add the garlic. Cook, stirring, for 30 seconds. Add the chicken stock and cream. Bring to a gentle simmer.
- 3)Add the uncooked pasta. Cook for 4 minutes, uncovered, stirring occasionally.
- 4) Scatter the broccoli (or vegetables of choice) on top of the pasta (see note. Place the lid on and cook for an additional 4 minutes, shuffling the pasta gently using your wooden spoon as required to ensure the pasta doesn't stick to the bottom of the pan.
- 5) Return the chicken to the pan and stir through the pesto and parmesan. Season with salt and pepper to taste, add fresh basil leaves and enjoy!


