Sundays, 9am - 5pm.

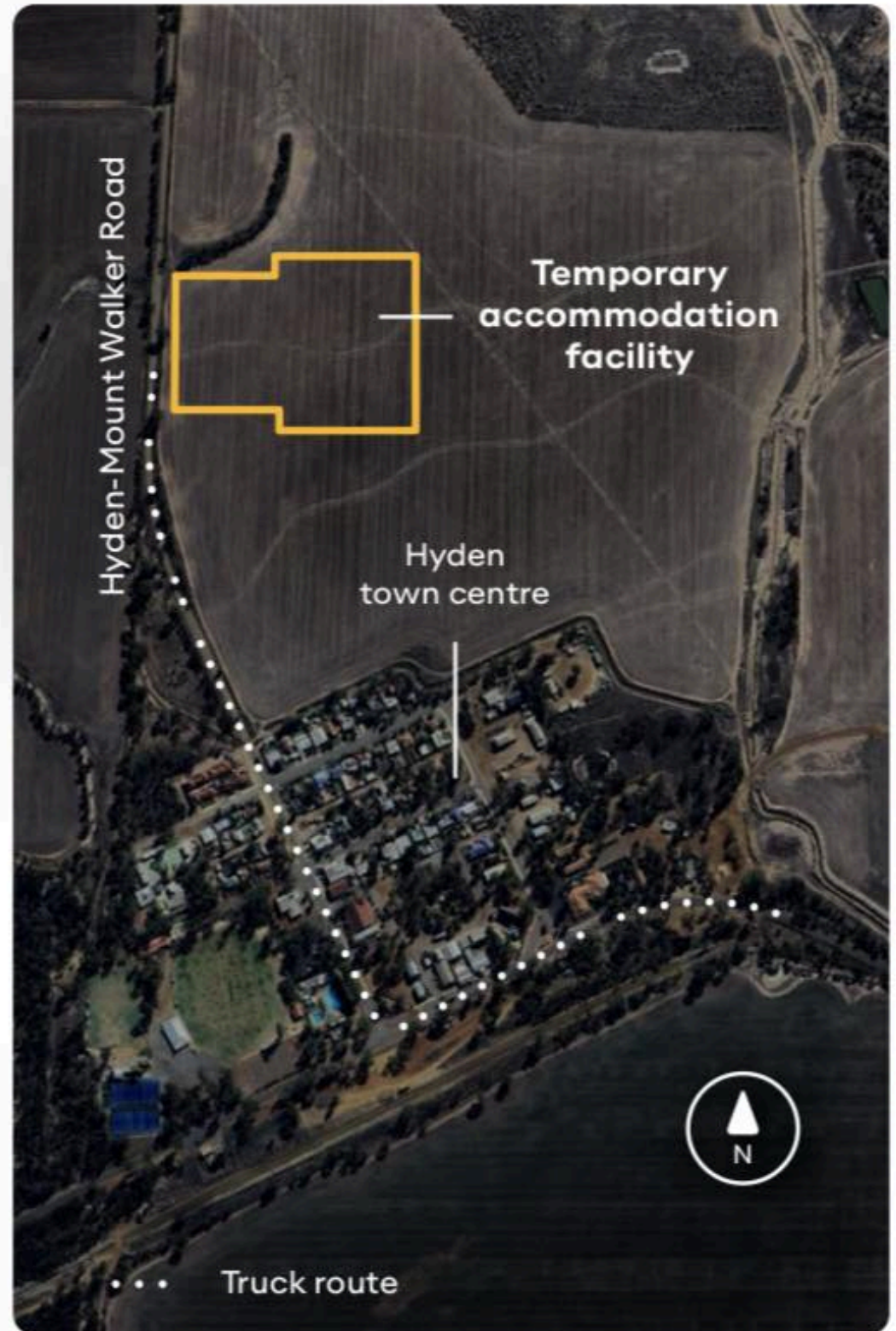
### What to expect

DLGSC encourages all local governments to promote this event to reach people in your community who may be interested in attending. We also encourage regional local governments to hold a screening of the forum in their town.

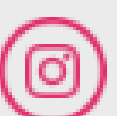

## **Temporary and Moveable Accommodation in the Shire of Kondinin**

A new Council policy, "Temporary and Moveable Accommodation Policy" and associated guidelines were endorsed at the Council meeting held on (date).

The development of the new policy and guidelines comes in response to changes made by the State Government in 2024 to Regulation 11 of the Caravan Parks and Camping Grounds Regulations 1997.

The regulation changes mean that:

1. A person may now camp on land that they own or have legal right to occupy for up to 5 nights in any period of 28 consecutive days, and
2. A local government may now approve an application from a person to camp on land they own or have a legal right to occupy within that local government area for a period up to 24 months, subject to conditions pertaining to health, safety and amenity of the caravan or camp, and the land on which the caravan or camp is located.

This policy will help ease the region's housing crisis, providing flexibility and supporting diverse housing needs, for example temporary accommodation for those building a house, short term transient worker accommodation options, additional accommodation for carers or family etc.

What can be approved under the policy?

- Self contained caravans, RV, bus, tiny home on wheels
- Campers and non-self-contained vans – subject to amenities
- Tents, roof top or similar – up to 30 days subject to amenities

What cannot be approved under the policy?

- Transportable dwellings such as dongas and modular accommodation - a planning application is required for these to be approved
- Sea containers, sheds and Class 10a structures - these structures are classed as out-buildings and are not deemed habitable by the Building Code, unless significant modifications are made which required a building permit.

There will be an online application form and the cost of the application is \$300

The Policy and guidelines will be available soon on the Shire's website.

## CEO COMMENTS

---

For those on the roads this time of the year, please be mindful of farm machinery that is moved around the farming areas. Also be aware of the School busses travelling on the roads during wet conditions.

### Council Meetings

For the June 2025 Ordinary Council Meeting, the following was discussed:

- Advertising the closure of the section of local road reserve (Land ID 3662697) that runs along the southern and eastern boundary of Lot 2425 on DP 169236 Walton Road, Karlgarin to amalgamate with the adjoining land.
- Council agreed to the amended concept plans for the construction of a multi-use building on Lot 500 Marshall Street, Hyden at the location of the existing Hyden Tennis Club building
- Council authorised the Chief Executive Officer to prepare an updated Quantity Surveyor Estimate based on the amended concept plans
- Council authorised the Chief Executive Officer to re-apply for the Department of Local Government Sports and Cultural Industries Community Sporting Recreation Facilities Fund (CSRFF) forward grant closing on the 30th September 2025 to seek funding for 1/3 of the total cost of the demolition of the existing tennis club building and construction of a multi-use -
- - building on Lot 151 Marshall Street, Hyden at the location of the existing Hyden Tennis Club building:
- Council will include the consultancy fees in the 25/26 budget for the preparation of the detailed design drawings should the grant application be successful.
- Council endorsed Policy EHO 002 - Temporary accommodation and associated Temporary Accommodation Guidelines and Temporary Accommodation and has set fee of \$300 per application in the 2025/2026 Fees and Charges.
- Council will amend Local Planning Scheme No. 1 via an omnibus amendment to incorporate recommendations of the new Local Planning Strategy and align to it with the Model Scheme Text and the Deemed Provisions.
- Council endorsed the Aviation Plan dated 6th June 2025. At a minimum the Four (4) turbines closest to the Kondinin airfield (K08, K15, K18 and K03) are lit as a precaution to avoid any aircraft accidents / collisions with consideration to being linked to the existing Pilot Activated Lighting (PAL) system at the Kondinin Aerodrome.
- Council endorsed the Electromagnetic interference (EMI) Assessment dated May 2025.
- Agreed to discontinuing charging the Kondinin Community Recreation Council for any electricity used at the Kondinin Sporting Precinct.
- Council adopted the fees and charges for the 2025/2026 financial year.
- Council will apply to the Minister for Local Government pursuant to Section 6.33(3) of the Local Government Act, 1995 seeking approval to apply the proposed differential rate between (UV) mining tenements, (UV) rural, (GRV) residential and (GRV) mining and the proposed minimum rates, advising the Minister that no objections were received within the public consultation process.

# Chicken Curry

 Total Time: 30 Minutes  Serves: 4



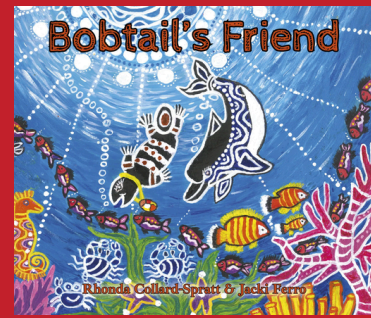
# Ingredients

- 1.5 tbsp oil (vegetable, canola)
- 2 garlic cloves , minced
- 2 tsp ginger , grated
- 1/2 onion , finely chopped
- 500g / 1lb chicken thighs, sliced (Note 1)
- 2.5 tbsp curry powder (Note 2)
- 270 ml / 1.25 cups coconut milk , full fat (9 oz) (Note 3)
- 1.5 cups (375 ml) chicken stock low sodium
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 3/4 cup frozen peas
- 1/4 cup coriander / cilantro leaves , chopped

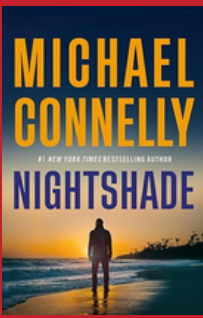
# Method

1. Heat oil in a skillet over medium high heat. Cook garlic, ginger and onion for 3 minutes until onion is translucent.
2. Add chicken and cook until it it changes from pink to white.
3. Add curry powder and cook for 2 minutes.
4. Add coconut milk and chicken stock. Stir, lower heat to medium and cook, simmering rapidly, for 10 minutes until sauce reduces and thickens.
5. Add peas and salt. Cook for a further 2 minutes, then taste to see if it needs more salt. Garnish with coriander.
6. Serve over rice, noodles or mashed potato!

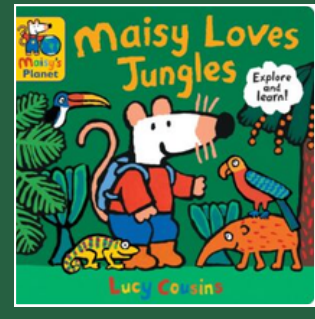
