FIRE BREAK NOTICE

FIRE BREAKS

You are required on or before 31 October each year, to plough, scarify, cultivate, spray or otherwise clear and maintain free of all inflammable material until 30 April the next year, firebreaks on the land owned or occupied by you pursuant to the powers contained in section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954.

RURAL LAND

Firebreaks not less than 3 metres wide as follows:

- i) Immediately inside all external boundaries of the land or rural holding and if any portion of the land or rural holding adjoins a public road or railway line a firebreak must also be constructed along that boundary.
- ii) Immediately surrounding all buildings, haystacks and fuel ramps situated on the land. Please contact the Shire for the requirements of setting fire to prepared bush.

TOWNSITE LAND

All townsite lots 2.012ha (5 acres) or less shall be clear of all inflammable materials and grass must be mown to a height of no greater than 15cm.

All town site lots or a combination of lots that comprise of one holding and greater than 2.012 ha (5 acres) require fire breaks of 1.25m wide on all boundaries and immediately surrounding all buildings.

If permission is not granted by Council or a duly authorised officer you shall comply with this Notice.

Share your **town and lifestyle**
with doctors of the future

More than 100 second-year medical students from Curtin University will participate in the Curtin Medical School Student Rural Immersion Week, with the aim of inspiring them to pursue careers in rural Western Australia.

During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and engage in community activities.

Do you live in or near Brookton, Corrigin, Dalwallinu, Katanning, Kondinin, Kulin, Moora or Wongan Hills?

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or more students for three nights, be able to assist with transporting them to/from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students.

Why host?

If you live in or near one of these towns we would love to hear from you!

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are more likely to explore rural career opportunities and have a better understanding of treating rural patients.

Some students continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs and some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine.

HEALTHWAY – HEALTHY COMMUNITIES PROGRAM



This program aims to fund a range of health promotion activities and campaigns to promote and encourage healthy lifestyles for all Western Australians.

The objectives of the program are to:

- Fund activities related to the promotion of good health in general and aligned with our strategic priorities and population groups.
- Support projects that aim to increase individual knowledge and skills, change behaviour, and create community and organisational policies and environments to improve health.

How much can I apply for? There are three funding categories available: 1. Up to \$5,000 funding, 2. Over \$5,000 funding & 3. Aboriginal health project funding.

LOTTERYWEST – GRASSROOTS COMMUNITY-LED GRANTS

This program aims to help build stronger and healthier communities by supporting local activities and regional community initiatives. It seeks to support big or small ideas that will contribute towards making the community better and healthier.

There are five priority areas for funding:

- Inclusive thriving community
- Connected cultural experiences
- Protected sustainable ecosystems
- Smart innovative society
- Active healthy people

Eligible Activities:

AFL COMMUNITY GRANTS



This program aims to make connections with people and organisations to learn where the greatest need is and turn those needs into opportunities.

AFL makes this possible through grants which target three areas:

- STEM education: Programs that provide children and adults access to a quality education through STEM (science, technology, engineering and math).
- Youth development: Programs that support healthy, productive and engaged children.
- LEAP (life enrichment and advancement program): Programs that support adults pursuing employment and self-sufficiency.

Hawaiian Chicken Kebabs

Ingredients

Method

 Serves: 5-6

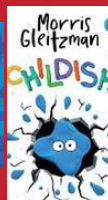


- 2 Small Red Onions (or one large)
- 1 Fresh Pineapple (or tinned pineapple pieces in juice)
- 600gm Chicken Breast
- 2 tablespoons Olive Oil
- 1 teaspoon Smoked Paprika
- 1 teaspoon Garlic Powder
- ¼ teaspoon Salt
- ¼ teaspoon Black Pepper
- ½ cup BBQ Sauce
- 2 Green Onions

1. Cut the red onions into 2cm squares. Place the red onion in a bowl, drizzle with 1 Tbsp cooking oil and coat.
2. Cut the pineapple into 2cm cubes.
3. Cut the chicken breast into 2cm cubes, then place the chicken pieces in a bowl. Drizzle 1 Tbsp cooking oil on top, then add the smoked paprika, garlic powder, salt, and pepper. Toss the chicken until it is well coated in oil and spices.
4. Build your kebabs by adding pineapple, onion, and chicken to skewers, alternating as you go. I got ten skewers, but the yield will vary depending on the length of your skewers and size of your pieces.
5. Heat a grill or grill pan over medium. Once hot, add the kebabs and cook for a few minutes on each side.
6. When the kebabs are almost cooked through, brush them on all sides with BBQ Sauce. Cook the chicken kebabs for a minute or two more on each side, or until the chicken is cooked through and the BBQ sauce is slightly caramelized.
7. Sprinkle the sliced green onions over top just before serving.
