


A concise account of Charles Darwin's voyage on the HMS Beagle and how it inspired the theory of evolution.






A gentle children's story that follows Murru on a journey of belonging, connection, and learning, celebrating culture, Country, and the importance of family and community.

Audit, Risk & Improvement Committee - 10 February 2026.

The Committee:

- Received and endorsed the Q2 (Mid Year) Budget Review, noting a modest surplus.
- Received and endorsed the Shire IT Security Review by LGIS (our Insurer).
- Noted the Committee Workplan updates and the pathway forward for 2026-2027.

Ordinary Meeting of Council - 11 February 2026.

The Council:

- Received and endorsed the Monthly Financial Reports (Statement of Financial Activity and Statement of Financial Position) for December 2025 and January 2025.
- Received and endorsed the List of Accounts padi for December 2025 and January 2026.
- Received and endorsed the Budget Review (Q2) - noting a very modest surplus.
- Endorsed the planning of a 2026 Seniors Week event in Hyden for the senior citizens of Hyden and Kondinin.
- Approved and endorsed the amalgamation of Lots 16 & 17 Lynch Street, Hyden (CWA Hall and Hyden Town Hall)
- Received the Western Australian Planning Commission's Renewable Energy Planning Code & Guidelines and endorsed a Shire submission to provide feedback on the Code.
- Endorsed the Shire to pursue commercial and residential lot land release through the Regional Development Assistance Program.
- Received supporting documentation to address development approval conditions of the King Rocks Windfarm.
- Endorsed a motion to the Australian Local Government Association to present to the Federal Government relating to the poor telecommunications service throughout the Shire.
- Endorsed two Councillors to attend the Australian Local Government Association and to undertake advocacy meetings with various Federal Ministries.
- Endorsed ongoing advocacy by the Shire President as a part of a consortium of Councils in relation to the Draft Guideline on Community Benefits for Renewable Energy Projects.
- Received and approved Main Roads endorsement to erect directional signage in Main Roads Reserve along Brookton Highway/Marshall Street, Hyden.

Capital Projects and Works Updates



Kondinin Pavilion

Works are progressing well at the Kondinin Pavilion. During February cladding is being completed for external and internal walls, with internal fit out to commence in March 2026. Works are scheduled to be completed by late April / early May 2026 in time for hosting winter sport.

This project has been made possible through funding through the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program, the State Governments' s Community Sports Recreation Facilities Fund, the Kondinin Community Recreation Council and the Shire of Kondinin.



Southern Wheatbelt Regional Drought Resilience Plan – Increase Storage Capacity at Bendering Tanks

The pad has been completed and the two new water tanks are scheduled to be installed on the 17 and 18 February 2026 at the Bendering Community Standpipes. This project has been made possible through grant funding received from the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development via the Wheatbelt Development Commission.

Karlgarin Bowling Club Building

The new Karlgarin Bowling Club building is largely completed and has been utilized during the latter part of the 25/26 bowls pennant season. Landscaping works are scheduled to commence on the 17 February 2026, including reinstating of pavers, garden beds, new boundary fencing and reinstatement of gates and bollards. There has been some issues identified with acoustics and lighting which are currently being addressed and solutions worked through. This building has been made possible through financial contributions from the Karlgarin Progress Association, the Karlgarin Bowling Club and the Shire of Kondinin.

Community Water Supply Program – Kondinin CBH and Karlgarin Bowling Club

Works have now been completed via grant funding received through the Department of Water and Environment's Community Water Supply Program, comprising two new water tanks being installed at the new Karlgarin Bowling Club and upgrades for the capture and storage of water from the Kondinin CBH site to the Kondinin Town Dams to reticulate the sporting precinct.

Hyden Golf Club

Works are scheduled to be completed at the Hyden Golf Club by Friday 20 February 2026, comprising new toilets, showers and change room areas. The upgraded facilities will be ready for use for the 2026 golf season.



Works crews have continued to make steady progress across the Shire, with several key projects underway and recently completed.

Gravel re-sheeting has been completed on Whyte Road, improving road conditions and safety for local users.

Road maintenance grading is also being carried out throughout the Shire, with ongoing maintenance currently focused on Lovering Road and surrounding roads servicing the King Rocks Windfarm.



Recent rainfall has been a welcome boost for the town ovals. Watering schedules will continue to be monitored and adjusted as required to maintain healthy playing surfaces while making the most of the improved conditions.

Australia Day BBQs were also held in Hyden and Kondinin, where we discovered our CEO has a weakness for soft-serve ice cream. Despite cooler weather and lower-than-usual attendance, the events still provided a great opportunity for residents to come together and celebrate.



Another fantastic community event was the Mega Splash Fun Day at the Hyden Swimming Pool, which saw a great turnout from local families. A big thank you to Contract Pool Services and Pool Manager Lucy for delivering such a wonderful event. The day was filled with plenty of smiles, with children enjoying the inflatable activities, sausage sizzle and fairy floss. We are also looking forward to the upcoming community movie night at the pool.

Looking ahead, planning is well underway for several key community events. Preparations have begun for the Kondinin Triathlon, which continues to be a popular and active event on the community calendar. Work is also progressing on the much-anticipated Gourmet in the Garden, a signature event that brings people together to enjoy local food, entertainment, and the community garden setting.

International Women's Day events are being planned in both Kondinin and Hyden, with a focus on celebrating the achievements of women and fostering connection within the community. Early planning has also commenced for NAIDOC Week activities across both towns, ensuring opportunities to recognise and celebrate Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture, history, and achievements. Community members are encouraged to have their say in shaping future activities. On behalf of our team, I'd like to sincerely thank the communities of Kondinin and Hyden for the warm welcome we've received so far. It's been wonderful meeting so many locals, and we're genuinely grateful for the kindness, patience, and support shown as we settle in.

We're also pleased to share that Dr Peter is settling in nicely and is really enjoying getting to know people across both towns. We're looking forward to building strong, long-term relationships and continuing to provide accessible, high-quality care close to home.

New services now available locally

We're excited to announce that there are now a number of new services available in Kondinin and Hyden, helping reduce the need to travel and making it easier for people to access timely testing and support.

Hearing tests are now available in both towns using state-of-the-art audiometric monitoring equipment, allowing for accurate assessment and monitoring of hearing concerns.

We also now offer spirometry, an easy and effective way to test lung function in children and adults. Spirometry can assist with assessing patients who already have a diagnosis, as well as those who are undiagnosed but may be experiencing symptoms. This testing supports screening and management for conditions such as asthma, COPD, and other lung-related issues.

In addition, we can provide:

- Drug and alcohol testing
- Pre-employment medicals
- Private and commercial driving licence medicals
- Firearms medicals
- Travel medicine

Supporting prevention and long-term health

We're passionate about preventative healthcare and are pleased to offer a range of services locally, including:

- Over 75 Health Checks
- 45-49 Health Checks
- Chronic Disease Management Plans
- Mental Health Care Plans

We're also supporting the current push towards heart health, with a focus on early identification of risk factors and practical steps people can take to protect long-term wellbeing.

As part of this, we now perform a two-stage Healthy Heart Check, and we're pleased to offer this fully bulk billed.

Stage 1 is an appointment with our Nurse, where we complete a thorough set of screening tests. This includes blood tests, an ECG, and a number of other screening tools to build a clear picture of your cardiovascular health. We then use these results to calculate your individual risk for heart concerns.

Stage 2 is a follow-up appointment with the Doctor around one week later, where you'll have the opportunity to go through your report in detail and, if needed, develop a personalised action plan to support your heart health moving forward.

Skin procedures close to home

Dr Peter also enjoys skin work and welcomes appointments to discuss any skin worries. He can view any suspicious skin concerns including moles or lesions with dermoscopy equipment, and where required can biopsy, cryotherapy or remove skin cancers locally, without the need to travel.


